21	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 5, Chapter 37, Subchapter 2, is amende	d
22	to add an additional section to read as follows:

24	(a) As used in this section, "United States Armed Forces" means:	
25	(1) Any branch or reserve component of the United States Armed	
26	Forces; and	
27	(2) The National Guard of any state.	
28	(b) A person commits the offense of stolen valor if, with the purpose	-
29	to obtain property, a service, or a benefit, he or she knowingly	
30	misrepresents himself or herself:	
31	(1) By the use of false military identification, including

33	(A) United States Department of Defense identification
