3	SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 3-4-207 is amended to read as follows:
4	3-4-207. Ineligible persons.
5	No The following persons described in this section shall <u>not</u> receive a
6	permit <u>under this title</u> :
7	(1) A person who has been convicted of a <u>an excluded</u> felony;
8	(2) A person under the age of twenty-one (21) years;
9	(3) A person who is not a citizen or resident alien of the
10	United States;
11	(4) A copartnership, unless all members of such copartnership
12	are citizens or resident aliens of the United States;
13	(5) A person who shall have had his or her permit issued under
14	this act <u>title</u> revoked for cause or who has been convicted of a violation of
15	this act until the expiration of two (2) years from the date of such
16	revocation or conviction; or
17	(6) A corporation or copartnership, if any of its officers or
18	members have been convicted of a violation of this act <u>title</u> or have had a
19	permit issued under this $\frac{1}{2}$ title revoked for cause until two (2) years from
20	the date of the conviction or revocation.
