8 AN ACT TO REAPPROPRIATE THE BALANCES OF CAPITAL
9 IMPROVEMENT APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE STATE MILITARY
10 DEPARTMENT; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

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13 AN ACT FOR THE STATE MILITARY DEPARTMENT
14 REAPPROPRIATION.
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18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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20 SECTION 1. REAPPROPRIATION - GENERAL IMPROVEMENT FUNDS. There is
21 hereby appropriated, to the State Military Department, to be payable from the
22 General Improvement Fund or its successor fund or fund accounts, for the
23 State Military Department the following:

24 (A) Effective July 1, 2017, the balance of the appropriation provided
25 in Item (D) Section 1 of Act 96 of 2016, for renovations to comply with ADA
26 requirements, in a sum not to exceed.....\$6,182.

27 (B) Effective July 1, 2017, the balance of the appropriation provided
28 in Item (E) Section 1 of Act 96 of 2016, for construction of the Camp
29 Robinson Readiness Center, in a sum not to exceed.....\$1,852,606.

30 (C) Effective July 1, 2017, the balance of the appropriation provided
31 in Item (F) Section 1 of Act 96 of 2016, for construction and renovation
32 projects for ADA compliance, in a sum not to exceed.....\$750,000.

33 (D) Effective July 1, 2017, the balance of the appropriation provided
34 in Item (G) Section 1 of Act 96 of 2016, for construction and renovation of a
35 Youth Program Facility, in a sum not to exceed.....\$10,000,000.
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1 SECTION 2. REAPPROPRIATION - FEDERAL FUNDS. There is hereby
2 appropriated, to the State Military Department, to be payable from the
3 federal funds as designated by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, for the
4 State Military Department the following:

5 (A) Effective July 1, 2017, the balance of the appropriation provided
6 in Item (G) Section 2 of Act 96 of 2016, for construction of a Combined
7 Support Maintenance Shop at Camp Robinson, in a sum not to exceed
8\$2,934,698.

9 (B) Effective July 1, 2017, the balance of the appropriation provided
10 in Item (H) Section 2 of Act 96 of 2016, for construction of the Searcy Field
11 Maintenance Shop, in a sum not to exceed.....\$1,873,325.

12 (C) Effective July 1, 2017, the balance of the appropriation provided
13 in Item (A) Section 2 of Act 96 of 2016, for construction of the Camp
14 Robinson Readiness Center, in a sum not to exceed.....\$5,557,817.

15 (D) Effective July 1, 2017, the balance of the appropriation provided
16 in Item (B) Section 2 of Act 96 of 2016, for construction and renovation of
17 Professional Education Center Dining Facility, in a sum not to exceed
18\$2,850,089.

19 (E) Effective July 1, 2017, the balance of the appropriation provided
20 in Item (C) Section 2 of Act 96 of 2016, for construction and renovation
21 projects for ADA compliance, in a sum not to exceed.....\$750,000.

22 (F) Effective July 1, 2017, the balance of the appropriation provided
23 in Item (D) Section 2 of Act 96 of 2016, for construction and renovation of
24 the Searcy Field Maintenance Shop, in a sum not to exceed.....\$7,407,510.

25 (G) Effective July 1, 2017, the balance of the appropriation provided
26 in Item (E) Section 2 of Act 96 of 2016, for construction of the Fort Chaffee
27 Live Fire/Entry Control Point, in a sum not to exceed.....\$5,187,100.

28 (H) Effective July 1, 2017, the balance of the appropriation provided
29 in Item (F) Section 2 of Act 96 of 2016, for construction of the Fort Chaffee
30 Sewer System, in a sum not to exceed.....\$3,220,223.

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32 SECTION 3. REAPPROPRIATION - CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS. There is hereby
33 appropriated, to the State Military Department, to be payable from the Armory
34 Construction Fund, for the State Military Department the following:

35 (A) Effective July 1, 2017, the balance of the appropriation provided
36 in Item (A) Section 3 of Act 96 of 2016, for repair, construction,

1 renovation, landscaping and maintenance of armories, hangars, and other
2 properties held for the use and benefit of the Arkansas National Guard, in a
3 sum not to exceed.....\$2,348,000.
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5 SECTION 4. DISBURSEMENT CONTROLS. (A) No contract may be awarded nor
6 obligations otherwise incurred in relation to the project or projects
7 described herein in excess of the State Treasury funds actually available
8 therefor as provided by law. Provided, however, that institutions and
9 agencies listed herein shall have the authority to accept and use grants and
10 donations including Federal funds, and to use its unobligated cash income or
11 funds, or both available to it, for the purpose of supplementing the State
12 Treasury funds for financing the entire costs of the project or projects
13 enumerated herein. Provided further, that the appropriations and funds
14 otherwise provided by the General Assembly for Maintenance and General
15 Operations of the agency or institutions receiving appropriation herein shall
16 not be used for any of the purposes as appropriated in this act.

17 (B) The restrictions of any applicable provisions of the State
18 Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the
19 Revenue Stabilization Law and any other applicable fiscal control laws of
20 this State and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and
21 Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in
22 disbursement of any funds provided by this act unless specifically provided
23 otherwise by law.
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25 SECTION 5. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
26 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
27 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
28 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
29 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
30 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
31 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
32 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.
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34 SECTION 6. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
35 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
36 appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the

1 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2017 is essential to the operation of
2 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
3 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the
4 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2017 could work irreparable harm
5 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
6 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
7 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
8 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2017.

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
