## For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO REAPPROPRIATE THE BALANCES OF CAPITAL  
IMPROVEMENT APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE NORTHWEST  
TECHNICAL INSTITUTE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

AN ACT FOR THE NORTHWEST TECHNICAL  
INSTITUTE REAPPROPRIATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. REAPPROPRIATION - GENERAL IMPROVEMENT. There is hereby appropriated, to the Northwest Technical Institute, to be payable from the General Improvement Fund or its successor fund or fund accounts, for the Northwest Technical Institute the following:

(A) Effective July 1, 2017, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (C) Section 2 of Act 97 of 2016, for transfers of or refund to expenditures for capital balances for construction, renovation, major maintenance, and purchase of equipment for various capital projects or facility improvements, in a sum not to exceed.....\$41,667.

(B) Effective July 1, 2017, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (G) Section 2 of Act 97 of 2016, for construction, renovation, maintenance, critical maintenance, equipment, security enhancements, technology upgrades/equipment and library resources, in a sum not to exceed.....\$2.

(C) Effective July 1, 2017, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (D) Section 2 of Act 97 of 2016, for Industrial Technology Center construction, parking, equipment, and furnishings costs, in a sum not to



1 exceed.....\$2,471,400.

2 (D) Effective July 1, 2017, the balance of the appropriation provided  
3 in Item (E) Section 2 of Act 97 of 2016, for Allied Health Facility  
4 construction, parking, equipment, and furnishings costs, in a sum not to  
5 exceed.....\$5,805,432.

6 (E) Effective July 1, 2017, the balance of the appropriation provided  
7 in Item (F) Section 2 of Act 97 of 2016, for transfers of or refund to  
8 expenditures for capital balances for construction, renovation, major  
9 maintenance, and purchase of equipment for various capital projects or  
10 facility improvements, in a sum not to exceed.....\$171,179.

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12 SECTION 2. REAPPROPRIATION - CASH. There is hereby appropriated, to  
13 the Northwest Technical Institute, to be payable from the cash funds as  
14 defined by Arkansas Code 19-4-801, for the Northwest Technical Institute the  
15 following:

16 (A) Effective July 1, 2017, the balance of the appropriation provided  
17 in Item (A) Section 1 of Act 97 of 2016, for Industrial Technology Center  
18 construction, parking, equipment, and furnishings costs, in a sum not to  
19 exceed.....\$55,000.

20 (B) Effective July 1, 2017, the balance of the appropriation provided  
21 in Item (B) Section 1 of Act 97 of 2016, for Allied Health Facility  
22 construction, parking, equipment, and furnishings costs, in a sum not to  
23 exceed.....\$80,000.

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25 SECTION 3. DISBURSEMENT CONTROLS. (A) No contract may be awarded nor  
26 obligations otherwise incurred in relation to the project or projects  
27 described herein in excess of the State Treasury funds actually available  
28 therefor as provided by law. Provided, however, that institutions and  
29 agencies listed herein shall have the authority to accept and use grants and  
30 donations including Federal funds, and to use its unobligated cash income or  
31 funds, or both available to it, for the purpose of supplementing the State  
32 Treasury funds for financing the entire costs of the project or projects  
33 enumerated herein. Provided further, that the appropriations and funds  
34 otherwise provided by the General Assembly for Maintenance and General  
35 Operations of the agency or institutions receiving appropriation herein shall  
36 not be used for any of the purposes as appropriated in this act.

1 (B) The restrictions of any applicable provisions of the State  
2 Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the  
3 Revenue Stabilization Law and any other applicable fiscal control laws of  
4 this State and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and  
5 Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in  
6 disbursement of any funds provided by this act unless specifically provided  
7 otherwise by law.

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9 SECTION 4. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General  
10 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations  
11 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for  
12 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive  
13 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget  
14 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or  
15 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative  
16 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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18 SECTION 5. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General  
19 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the  
20 appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the  
21 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2017 is essential to the operation of  
22 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in  
23 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the  
24 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2017 could work irreparable harm  
25 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental  
26 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act  
27 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health  
28 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2017.
