Arkansas Code § 8-6-612 is repealed. 19 8-6-612. Landfill disposal fees to support a computer and electronic 20 equipment recycling program. 21 (a)(1) Except as provided in subsection (b) or (d) of this section, 22 there is imposed on each landfill permittee a landfill disposal fee of: 23 (A) Fifteen cents (15¢) for each uncompacted cubic yard of 24 solid waste; and 25 (B) Thirty cents (30¢) for each compacted cubic yard of 26 solid waste received at the landfill. 27 (2) If a landfill permittee is required or chooses to operate on 28 a weight basis, the landfill disposal fee shall be one dollar (\$1.00) for each one (1) ton of solid waste received at the landfill. 29 30 (b) The following are exempt from payment of fees under subsection (a) 31 of this section: 32 (1) A solid waste transporter as defined in § 8-6-603; and 33 (2) A landfill permitee that is a private industry that bears 34 the expense of operating and maintaining the landfill solely for the disposal

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- SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 8-6-613 is amended to read as follows:
- 11 8-6-613. Computer and electronic equipment recycling program.
- 12 (a) A program for the recycling of computer and electronic equipment 13 is created.
 - (b) The General Assembly finds that:
- 15 (1) Computer and electronic equipment solid waste are among the
- 16 fastest growing and most toxic segments of Arkansas's solid waste stream; and
- 17 (2) There are recycling options to address this problem, and
- 18 Arkansas solid waste districts and local governments and their delegated
- 19 authorities and agents should develop solid waste management plans, programs,
- 20 and facilities that integrate computer and electronic equipment recycling as
- 21 a functional part of the solid waste management system.
- 22 (c) Each regional solid waste management board that is required to
- 23 submit or has submitted a regional solid waste management plan under § 8-6-
- 24 1904 or a solid waste management plan developed under the Arkansas Solid
- 25 <u>Waste Management Act, § 8-6-201 et seq.</u>, and receives funding under this
- 26 <u>subchapter shall operate a solid waste management system that includes a</u>
- 27 <u>computer and electronic equipment recycling program.</u>
- 28 (e)(d) The Arkansas Pollution Control and Ecology Commission may adopt
 29 reasonable rules regulations necessary to implement an effective computer and
- 30 electronic equipment recycling program.

- SECTION 4. Arkansas Code \S 8-6-615(a)(1)(A), concerning the
- 33 distribution of funds to regional solid waste management districts, is
- 34 amended to read as follows:
- 35 (a)(1)(A) Funds collected under $\frac{\$ 8 6 607}{$}$ this subchapter and
- 36 deposited into the State Treasury to the credit of the Solid Waste Management

1 and Recycling Fund, less up to twenty percent (20%) for administrative 2 support for the Arkansas Department of Environmental Quality, shall be allocated annually to each of the approved regional solid waste management 3 4 districts utilizing a combination of the two (2) methods stated in 5 subsections (b) and (c) of this section. 6 7 SECTION 5. Arkansas Code § 8-6-615, concerning the distribution of 8 funds to regional solid waste management districts, is amended to add an 9 additional subsection to read as follows: 10 (d)(1) After the effective date of this act and for each subsequent 11 fiscal year, each regional solid waste management board that receives funds 12 under this section shall provide a report by November 1 to the department that explains how the regional solid waste management board spent the funding 13 received under this section in the previous fiscal year. 14 15 (2) The report under this subsection shall include the following 16 information concerning the amount of expenditures in the previous fiscal year 17 from the funds received under this section for: 18 (A) Equipment and material purchases; and 19 (B) Operation costs. (3) The report shall be in a spreadsheet form as prescribed by 20 21 the Department. 22 (4) The Arkansas Pollution Control and Ecology Commission may 23 promulgate regulations necessary for funding and program reporting, 24 accountability, and oversight under this subsection. 25 26 SECTION 6. Arkansas Code § 8-6-616 is repealed. 27 8-6-616. Distribution of funds to regional solid waste management 28 districts for computer and electronic equipment recycling programs. (a)(1) Funds collected under § 8-6-612 and deposited as special 29 30 revenues into the State Treasury to the credit of the Solid Waste Management and Recycling Fund for support of an approved computer and electronic 31 32 equipment recycling program shall be allocated annually to each regional 33 solid waste management district using a combination of the two (2) methods 34 stated in subsections (b) and (c) of this section. 35 (2) Fifty percent (50%) of the funds shall be determined using

the method provided in subsection (b) of this section, and fifty percent

1 (50%) shall be determined using the method provided in subsection (c) of this 2 section. 3 (3) The total figures obtained from each method shall be 4 combined to arrive at each regional solid waste management district's fund 5 distribution. 6 (b)(1)(A) The Arkansas Department of Environmental Quality shall 7 determine the amount of funds within each planning and development district 8 organized under § 14-166-201 et seq. and recognized by the Governor based on 9 the same distribution as general revenue support is distributed to the 10 planning and development districts in the current fiscal year. 11 (B) The department shall adjust the distribution described 12 in subdivision (b)(1)(A) of this section within the planning and development districts to coincide with the boundaries of the regional solid waste 13 14 management districts by determining each county's share of the funds 15 available within each planning and development district. 16 (C) Each county's share shall be based on the proportion 17 that each county's population bears to the total population in the planning and development district to which the county is assigned, multiplied by the 18 amount of funds determined to be available within the planning and 19 20 development district. 21 (D) The county's proportional share as determined under 22 this subdivision (b)(1) shall be added to all other counties' shares within 23 the same regional solid waste management district. 24 (2) The formula to be used under this subsection is as follows: (A) Divide fifty percent (50%) of the total remaining 25 26 funds equally by the eight (8) regional planning and development districts; 27 (B) Multiply the quotient obtained under subdivision 28 (b)(2)(A) of this section by the most recent federal decennial census 29 population of each county; and 30 (C)(i) Divide the product obtained under subdivision (b)(2)(B) of this section by the planning and development district population 31 32 in which the county is located to determine the portion per county. 33 (ii) Individual county portions are grouped and 34 totaled by each new regional solid waste management district to determine each regional solid waste management district's allocation. 35 36 (c)(1) The remaining fifty percent (50%) of the funds shall be based

1	on the ratio of the district's 2010 or current decennial census population
2	divided by the most recent federal decennial census state population.
3	(2) The formula to be used under this subsection is as follows:
4	(A) Divide each regional solid waste management district's
5	total population by the state's most recent federal decennial census
6	population; and
7	(B) Multiply the quotient obtained under subdivision
8	(c)(2)(A) of this section by the total remaining funds to determine each
9	regional solid waste management district's allocation.
10	(d) A regional solid waste management district shall receive for an
11	approved computer and electronic equipment recycling program from the
12	regional solid waste management district's allocation:
13	(1) After July 22, 2015, ten percent (10%) of the funds for that
14	year as calculated by the department using a combination of the two (2)
15	methods stated in subsections (b) and (c) of this section; and
16	(2) For a year in which the regional solid waste management
17	district did not receive funds to cover administrative costs of an approved
18	computer and electronic equipment recycling program, ten percent (10%) of the
19	funds currently on hand for that year.
20	(e)(1) Funds received under this section by a regional solid waste
21	management district but not needed for computer and electronic equipment
22	recycling may be used for another recycling project operated by the regional
23	solid waste management district.
24	(2) Funds may be redirected under subdivision (d)(1) of this
25	section only if the regional solid waste management board that governs a
26	regional solid waste management district certifies that the funds are not
27	needed for the approved computer and electronic equipment recycling program.
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29	SECTION 7. Arkansas Code § 8-6-1002(a)(3), concerning the Landfill
30	Post-Closure Trust Fund, is amended to read as follows:
31	(3) (A) Moneys received into the fund may also be used by the Arkansas
32	Department of Environmental Quality for administrative purposes at a level
33	not to exceed three hundred thousand dollars (\$300,000) annually with an
34	annual escalator not to exceed three percent (3%).
35	(B) In the event the total amount in the fund equals or
36	exceeds twenty-five million dollars (\$25,000,000), no additional moneys shall

1 be collected pursuant to this subchapter until the total amount in the fund 2 equals or is less than fifteen million dollars (\$15,000,000) at which time 3 the collection of moneys shall resume. 4 5 SECTION 8. Arkansas Code § 19-5-961(a), concerning the Solid Waste 6 Management and Recycling Fund, is amended to read as follows: 7 (a) There is established on the books of the Treasurer of State, the 8 Auditor of State, and the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State a trust fund to 9 be known as the "Solid Waste Management and Recycling Fund". 10 11 SECTION 9. DO NOT CODIFY. <u>Distribution of funds from landfill</u> 12 disposal fees. (a)(1) The Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall determine the total 13 14 moneys available on the day before the effective date of this act at 11:59 p.m. that were collected under \S 8-6-612 for computer and electronic 15 16 equipment recycling programs. 17 (2) The moneys available under subdivision (a)(1) of this 18 section shall be used to fund computer and electronic equipment recycling 19 programs under Arkansas Code § 8-6-613(c) until all moneys are distributed as 20 provided under this subsection. 21 (3)(A) The use of any interest earnings or investment earnings 22 on the moneys available under subdivision (a)(1) of this section shall not be 23 restricted to computer and electronic equipment recycling programs after the 24 effective date of this act. 25 (B) The interest earnings and investment earnings on the 26 moneys available under this subsection shall be used as provided under § 8-6-27 605. 28 (4)(A) For each fiscal year, five hundred thousand dollars 29 (\$500,000) of the moneys available under subdivision (a)(1) of this section 30 shall be added to the distribution of funding to regional solid waste management districts under Arkansas Code § 8-6-615. 31 32 (B) When the balance of the moneys allocated under 33 subdivision (a)(1) of this section is less than five hundred thousand dollars 34 (\$500,000) for a fiscal year, all of the available moneys remaining in the

fund shall be the last moneys used to supplement the distribution to the

regional solid waste management districts under § 8-6-615 for that fiscal

1	year.
2	(5) For each fiscal year, the Arkansas Department of
3	Environmental Quality shall determine the amount of the moneys allocated
4	under subdivision (a)(4) of this section that are included in each regional
5	solid waste management district's fund distribution under § 8-6-615 and
6	provide that information to the regional solid waste management districts.
7	(6)(A) Except as otherwise provided under subdivision (a)(6)(B)
8	of this section, each regional solid waste management district shall use the
9	moneys received under subdivision (a)(5) of this section for computer and
10	electronic equipment recycling programs.
11	(B) Moneys received under this section by a regional solid
12	waste management district but not needed for computer and electronic
13	equipment recycling may be used for another recycling project operated by the
14	regional solid waste management district only if the regional solid waste
15	management board that governs a regional solid waste management district
16	certifies that the funds are not needed for the approved computer and
17	electronic equipment recycling program.
18	(b) This section expires after the final distribution of the moneys
19	allocated under subdivision (a)(4)(B) of this section to the regional solid
20	waste management districts.
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
