1 (2) For purposes of this act, the Arkansas Agriculture 2 Department shall be considered a principal department established by Acts 3 1971, No. 38. 4 (b) The boards, commissions, or other governing bodies of the 5 Abandoned Pesticide Advisory Board, the Arkansas Forestry Commission, the 6 Arkansas Livestock and Poultry Commission, the State Plant Board, the 7 Arkansas Farm Mediation Office, the Veterinary Medical Examining Board, and 8 the Arkansas State Board of Registration for Foresters are retained and shall 9 continue to exercise their statutory authority, powers, duties, and 10 functions. (c)(1) The directors, if any, of the Abandoned Pesticide Advisory 11 12 Board, the Arkansas Forestry Commission, the Arkansas Livestock and Poultry 13 Commission, the State Plant Board, the Arkansas Farm Mediation Office, the Veterinary Medical Examining Board, and the Arkansas State Board of 14 15 Registration for Foresters shall be nominated by the board, commission, or 16 governing body of the Abandoned Pesticide Advisory Board, the Arkansas 17 Forestry Commission, the Arkansas Livestock and Poultry Commission, the State 18 Plant Board, the Arkansas Farm Mediation Office, the Veterinary Medical 19 Examining Board, and the Arkansas State Board of Registration for Foresters 20 subject to confirmation by the Governor. (2) The directors, if any, of the Abandoned Pesticide Advisory 21 22 Board, the Arkansas Forestry Commission, the Arkansas Livestock and Poultry 23 Commission, the State Plant Board, the Arkansas Farm Mediation Office, the 24 Veterinary Medical Examining Board, and the Arkansas State Board of 25 Registration for Foresters shall serve at the pleasure of the Governor. (d) All records, personnel, property, unexpended balances of 26 27 appropriations, allocations, or other funds, including the functions of budgeting and purchasing, are transferred to the principal department. 28 29 (e) The members of any statutory board or commission of the Abandoned Pesticide Advisory Board, the Arkansas Forestry Commission, the Arkansas 30 Livestock and Poultry Commission, the State Plant Board, the Arkansas Farm 31 32 Mediation Office, the Veterinary Medical Examining Board, and the Arkansas State Board of Registration for Foresters are transferred and their 33 34 successors shall continue to be selected in the manner and serve for the 35 terms provided by the statutes applicable to the board or commission as such 36 statutes may from time to time be amended.

- 1 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 2-7-201 is amended to read as follows:
- 2 2-7-201. Creation.
- 3 (a) There is hereby created within the $\frac{Arkansas\ Development\ Finance}{Arkansas\ Development\ Finance}$
- 4 Authority Arkansas Agriculture Department the Arkansas Farm Mediation Office
- 5 which shall administer the Arkansas Farm Mediation Program to provide
- 6 mediation and debt management services to farmers and their creditors in the
- 7 State of Arkansas.
- 8 (b)(1) The program shall be administered by the President of the
- 9 Arkansas Development Finance Authority Secretary of the Arkansas Agriculture
- 10 <u>Department</u> who shall employ mediators and administrative staff in such
- 11 numbers as are necessary and as the General Assembly may appropriate to carry
- 12 out the provisions of this chapter.
- 13 (2) The president Secretary of the Arkansas Agriculture
- 14 <u>Department</u> may apply to the United States Secretary of Agriculture or any
- 15 other agency or department for any financial assistance for the
- 16 administration and operation of the program.
- 17 (3) The president Secretary of the Arkansas Agriculture
- 18 <u>Department</u> or his or her designee shall select mediators who are
- 19 knowledgeable in the areas of finance, agriculture, and negotiation and shall
- 20 train them in any other matters as are necessary to carry out their functions
- 21 under this chapter.
- 22 (4) The president Secretary of the Arkansas Agriculture
- 23 Department may promulgate rules to carry out the provisions of this chapter.

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- 25 SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 25-38-203(4)-(10), concerning the powers
- 26 and duties of the Arkansas Agriculture Department, are amended to read as
- 27 follows:
- 28 (4) Develop a website devoted to marketing and education
- 29 concerning agriculture, aquaculture, horticulture, forestry, and kindred
- 30 industries, including a distinctive logo publicizing products as "Grown in
- 31 Arkansas "Arkansas Grown" and "Arkansas Made";
- 32 (5) Encourage the organization of neighborhood and county
- 33 agricultural clubs and associations;
- 34 (6) Coordinate the various activities of the department with
- 35 those of the federal government and other states on matters pertaining to
- 36 agriculture, aquaculture, horticulture, forestry, and kindred industries and

1 enter into agreements for that purpose; 2 (7) Coordinate with existing programs concerning agriculture, 3 aquaculture, horticulture, forestry, and kindred industries with the 4 University of Arkansas Division of Agriculture and other agricultural 5 universities of this state; 6 (8) Make all contracts and grants and employ, to the extent 7 funds are available, such personnel as may be necessary to carry out the 8 purposes of this chapter; and 9 (9) Assist other departments, agencies, and institutions of the 10 state and federal governments, when so requested, by performing services in 11 conformity with the purposes of this chapter-; 12 (10) Designate employees who shall have the powers of peace 13 officers in the enforcement of criminal laws pertaining to the agricultural 14 and forestry industries of this state; and 15 (11) Promulgate rules necessary to carry out the powers and duties of the department and provide for the orderly administration of the 16 17 department. 18 19 SECTION 4. Arkansas Code § 25-38-204 is amended to read as follows: 20 25-38-204. Type 1 4 transfers of various agricultural agencies. 21 The following departments, institutions, other agencies, or parts 22 thereof, are transferred to the Arkansas Agriculture Department by a type 1 4 23 transfer, as provided for $\frac{1}{2}$ \frac{25-2-104}{2} under \{ 25-2-107, under which the 24 departments, institutions, other agencies, or parts thereof, shall be 25 administered under the direction and supervision of that principal 26 department, but shall retain the same prescribed statutory powers, 27 authorities, duties, and functions as they had before the transfer boards and commissions of the transferred agencies are retained and shall continue to 28 29 exercise their statutory authority, powers, duties, and functions: 30 (1) Abandoned Pesticide Advisory Board, created under § 8-7-31 1204; 32 (2) Arkansas Forestry Commission, created under § 15-31-101; 33 (3) Arkansas Livestock and Poultry Commission, created under § 2-33-101; 34 (4) State Plant Board, created under § 2-16-206; and 35 36 (5) Aquaculture business enterprise facilities and operations

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8	SECTION 5. Arkansas Code § 25-38-206(a), concerning the transfer of		
9	human resources and accounting offices of various agricultural agencies, is		
10	amended to read as follows:		
11	(a) The human resource and accounting operations of the following		
12	boards and commissions shall be administered under the direction and		
13	supervision of the Arkansas Agriculture Department:		
14	(1) The State Plant Board;		
15	(2) The Arkansas Livestock and Poultry Commission; and		
16	(3) The Arkansas Forestry Commission:		
17	(4) Veterinary Medical Examining Board; and		
18	(5) Arkansas State Board of Registration for Foresters.		
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20	SECTION 6. Arkansas Code § 25-38-207, concerning duties of the		
21	Arkansas Agriculture Board, is amended to add an additional subsection to		
22	read as follows:		
23	(h) The Arkansas Agriculture Board shall report annually to the		
24	Legislative Council at the end of the fiscal year.		
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
