- 31 <u>election</u>, or general election, the special election shall be held not less
- 32 than sixty (60) days following the date established in the proclamation,

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SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 7-11-106 is amended to read as follows:

1 7-11-106. Special primary elections held in conjunction with regularly 2 scheduled primary election - Separate ballots optional. 3 (a) When a special primary election is held on the date of the 4 preferential primary or general primary election, the candidates to be voted 5 upon at the special primary election shall be included on the ballot of each 6 political party, and the portion of the ballot on which the special primary 7 election appears shall be labeled with a heading stating "SPECIAL PRIMARY " with the name of the party for which nomination is 8 ELECTION FOR 9 sought and the office set out in the heading. 10 The county board of election commissioners may include the special 11 primary election on a separate ballot if the special primary election is held 12 at the same time as a preferential primary election or general primary election and the commission determines that a separate ballot is necessary to 13 14 avoid voter confusion. 15 16 SECTION 4. Arkansas Code § 7-11-205(a)(1), concerning dates of special 17 elections on measures and questions, is amended to read as follows: 18 (a)(1)(A) Except as provided in subdivision (a)(1)(B) of this section, 19 all special elections on measures or questions shall be held on the second 20 Tuesday of any month, except special elections held under this section in a 21 month in which a preferential primary election, general primary election, or 22 general election is scheduled to occur shall be held on the date of the 23 preferential primary election, general primary election, or general election. 24 (B)(i) Special elections scheduled to occur in a month in 25 which the second Tuesday is a legal holiday shall be held on the third 26 Tuesday of the month. 27 (ii) A special election called in June of an evennumbered year shall be held on the fourth Tuesday of the month. 28 29 30 31 32 33 34 35

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
