22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

24 *SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 4-88-101(3), concerning the applicability*
25 *of the chapter governing deceptive trade practices, is amended to read as*
26 *follows:*

27 *(3) Actions or transactions specifically permitted under laws*
28 *administered by the Insurance Commissioner, the Securities Commissioner, the*
29 *State Highway Commission, the Bank Commissioner, or other regulatory body or*
30 *officer acting under statutory authority of this state or the United States,*
31 *unless a director of these divisions specifically requests the Attorney*
32 *General to implement the powers of this chapter; or"*
