dollars (\$100,000) for the preceding year Maintains a liability policy with a minimum coverage of one million dollars (\$1,000,000); (D) For a fee, prepares food and beverages to be consumed at private parties or other private functions; and (E) Transports the food and beverages from the permitted premises to the premises where the private function is being held; and (4)(3) "Off-premise Off-premises caterer's permit" means a license which that authorizes the holder thereof to purchase alcoholic beverages from a permitted retail outlet, to transport the alcoholic beverages to a private function which that is being catered by the permit holder, and to serve alcoholic beverages to attendees of a private function in conjunction with catered food. SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 3-4-903(b), concerning qualifications for off-premise caterer's permits, is amended to read as follows: (b)(1) Furthermore, no An off-premise off-premises caterer's permit shall not be issued until the applicant provides proof of general liability insurance providing coverage in an amount of no less than two hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000) one million dollars (\$1,000,000). (2) If the off-premises caterer provides liquor as part of its service, liquor liability shall be included in the coverage under subdivision (b)(1) of this section.
