13	(a) All colleges and universities in this state that are sustained or
14	in any manner supported by public funds shall give instructions in the
15	essentials of the United States Constitution, including the study of and
16	devotion to American institutions and ideals.
17	(b) No student in the colleges, universities, or other educational
18	institutions shall receive a certificate of graduation without previously
19	passing a satisfactory examination upon the provisions and principles of the
20	United States Constitution.
21	(c) The instruction provided for in subsection (a) of this section
22	shall be given in all junior and senior classes of colleges, universities,
23	and educational institutions.
24	(d) Willful neglect or failure on the part of the president or teacher
25	or other officer of any normal or other school or college to observe and
26	carry out the requirements of this section shall be sufficient cause for the
27	dismissal or removal of that party from his or her position.
