- 29 (C)(i) A custodian of records under subdivision (a)(1)(A)
- 30 of this section may meet the requirements of this section by allowing for the
- 31 inspection of public records in a searchable electronic form via the
- 32 internet.
- 33 (ii) This subdivision (a)(1)(C) expires four (4)
- years after the effective date of this act. 34

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
