## For An Act To Be Entitled

8 AN ACT TO AMEND THE ARKANSAS PROCUREMENT LAW; TO  
9 AMEND THE VENDOR REPORTING REQUIREMENTS FOR STATE  
10 CONTRACTS; TO REPEAL CERTAIN PROVISIONS OF THE  
11 ARKANSAS PROCUREMENT LAW; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

14 TO AMEND THE ARKANSAS PROCUREMENT LAW;  
15 AND TO AMEND THE VENDOR REPORTING  
16 REQUIREMENTS FOR STATE CONTRACTS.

20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
21

22 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 19-11-268(a)(1), concerning vendor  
23 performance reporting under the Arkansas Procurement Law, is amended to read  
24 as follows:

25 (a)(1) A state agency shall report a vendor's performance under a  
26 contract executed under this subchapter that has a total initial contract  
27 amount or total projected contract amount, including any amendments to or  
28 possible extensions of the contract, of at least ~~twenty-five thousand dollars~~  
29 ~~(\$25,000)~~ one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000).  
30

31 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 19-11-268, concerning vendor performance  
32 reporting under the Arkansas Procurement Law, is amended to add an additional  
33 subsection to read as follows:

34 (c) As used in this section, "contract" does not include a one-time  
35 purchase order for commodities.

~~19-11-270. Penalty for intentional violation.~~

~~A person who purposely violates state procurement laws, Arkansas Code Title 19, Chapter 11, upon conviction is guilty of a Class D felony.~~

SECTION 4. Arkansas Code § 19-11-1013(a)(1), concerning vendor performance reporting with respect to professional and consultant services contracts, is amended to read as follows:

(a)(1) A state agency shall report a vendor's performance under a contract issued under this subchapter that has a total initial contract amount or total projected contract amount, including any amendments to or possible extensions of the contract, of at least ~~twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000)~~ for contracts one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000).
