16 STUDENTS A PANIC BUTTON ALERT SYSTEM.

19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

21 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 6, Chapter 61, Subchapter 1, is amended
22 to add an additional section to read as follows:

23 6-61-139. Panic button alert systems.

24 (a) A state-supported institution of higher education shall offer to
25 its students, employees, and other personnel a panic button alert system
26 that:

27 (1) Connects the user in real time with designated individuals,
28 with the ability of contacting a live 911 operator;

29 (2)(A) Directly integrates into the existing statewide Smart911
30 system.

31 (B) The Smart911 system shall provide a way for a state-
32 supported institution of higher education to geofence the campus and provide
33 the GPS location to assist emergency responders by automatically displaying
34 during a 911 call;

35 (3) Is available for use on and off campus as a smartphone
36 application and has a mechanism for panic notifications to be triggered by



1 non-smartphone wireless callers and landline callers or automatic alert
2 features in the event the user is unable to respond; and

3 (4) Has geotracking capability that can determine the location
4 and movements of the person who engaged the panic alert system.

5 (b) A state-supported institution of higher education may charge its
6 students, employees, and other personnel no more than two dollars (\$2.00) per
7 year for the use of the panic button alert system.
