2	Transportation Department to inspect all the data collected and maintained		
3	relating to an accident locations on the state highway system in Arkansas, as		
4	reported to the Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department by the		
5	Department of Arkansas State Police pursuant to <u>under</u> § 27-53-207(b), where		
6	accidents which resulted in a human fatality occurred within the preceding		
7	twelve-month period and where two (2) or more accidents involving a personal		
8	bodily injury occurred at the same location.		
9	(2) The inspections shall determine, within the judgment of		
LO	Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department personnel, whether		
l 1	safety improvements, increased visibility, warning signs, traffic control		
12	devices, or any other safety improvements are $\frac{\text{warranted}}{\text{mecessary}}$ which could
