23	(a) For purpose	es of this section, the term "vested	-permits" is defined
24	as those multiple reta	ail liquor permits which were lawful	ly issued to any
25	person, firm, or corpo	oration prior to July 19, 1971.	
26	(b)(1)(A) No <u>(ε</u>	a)(1)(A) A retail liquor permit sha	ll <u>not</u> be issued,
27	either as a new permit	or as a replacement of an existing	permit, to any
28	person, firm, or corpo	oration if the person, firm, or corporation	oration has any
29	interest in another re	etail liquor permit, regardless of t	he degree of
30	interest.		
31	(B)	A retail liquor permit shall apply	<u>applies</u> only to one
32	(1) location, and a pe	erson, firm, or corporation shall no	t be permitted to
33	receive any direct or	indirect financial benefit from the	sale of liquor at

4	(c)(1)(b)(1) Holders of vested permits A holder of a retail liquor		
5	permit may not sell, convey, assign, or devise any such interest in multiple		
6	retail liquor permitted businesses to any person or persons, firm, or		
7	corporation which, on the date of any such transfer, already has any		
8	ownership interest in a permitted retail liquor business.		
9	(2) However, holders of vested permits shall be allowed to \underline{a}		
10	holder of a retail liquor permit may sell, convey, assign, or devise any such		
11	interest in multiple retail liquor permitted businesses to any other person		
12	or persons, firm, or corporation, thereby creating an ownership interest in		
13	more than one (1) retail liquor permit to any such subsequent purchasers,		
14	assignees, or devisees without violating any of the provisions $\frac{1}{2}$		
15	this section.		
16	(d)(c) A holder of a vested retail liquor permit may brand each of the		
17	businesses that is operated under the $\frac{vested}{vested}$ retail liquor permit with the		
18	same name or logo, or both.
