10	in the county;		
11	(iv) The availability and accessibility of fire		
12	protection services, including firefighting machinery and equipment and the		
13	number of necessary firefighters to combat fires; and		
14	(v) The geographic location of the fire departments		
15	in the county and in the state.		
16	(c) A fire department participating in the program shall:		
17	(1) Apply for grants under the program; and		
18	(2) Operate to improve the fire department's public protection		
19	classification system rating.		
20	(d) The Arkansas Department of Emergency Management shall promulgate		
21	rules for implementation of the program which shall make available funds for		
22	the program to be used in defraying the initial cost of equipment, repair,		
23	furnishing, and adaptation of vehicles as fire trucks, or other firefighting		
24	machinery and equipment, and to make grants, as provided in this section, to		
25	counties participating in the program to provide a portion of the moneys		
26	required to enable the fire departments to acquire vehicles and other		
27	firefighting machinery and equipment from the Arkansas Department of		
28	Emergency Management or personnel or services necessary to prepare for a		
29	public protection classification rating review.		
30	(e) The Arkansas Department of Emergency Management shall adopt rules		
31	to administer the program for eligible counties, including without		
32	limitation, rules that address:		
33	(1) Applications;		
34	(2) Administration; and		
35	(3) Reporting requirements.		
36	<u>(f)(l) A county participating in the program shall evaluate the</u>		

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1	effectiveness of the program in each participating fire department located in		
2	the county by measuring:		
3	(A) Costs associated with administering and operating the		
4	fire department after receiving additional firefighting machinery and		
5	equipment under the program; and		
6	(B) The amount of improvement of a participating fire		
7	department's public protection classification system rating level.		
8	(2)(A) The fire department shall submit an annual report to the		
9	Arkansas Department of Emergency Management.		
10	(B) The annual report described in subdivision (f)(2)(A)		
11	of this section shall be filed by January 31 of each year.		
12	(g) The program shall expire on July 1, 2021, unless it is continued		
13	by the General Assembly.		
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
