25	the program to be used in defraying the initial cost of equipment, repair,		
26	furnishing, and adaptation of vehicles as fire trucks, or other firefighting		
27	machinery and equipment, and to make grants, as provided in this section, to		
28	counties participating in the program to provide a portion of the moneys		
29	required to enable the fire departments to acquire vehicles and other		
30	firefighting machinery and equipment from the Arkansas Department of		
31	Emergency Management or personnel or services necessary to prepare for a		
32	public protection classification rating review.		
33	(e) The Arkansas Department of Emergency Management shall adopt rules		
34	to administer the program for eligible counties, including without

3	(f)(1) A county participating in the program shall evaluate the
4	effectiveness of the program in each participating fire department located in
5	the county by measuring:
6	(A) Costs associated with administering and operating the
7	fire department after receiving additional firefighting machinery and
8	equipment under the program; and
9	(B) The amount of improvement of a participating fire
10	department's public protection classification system rating level.
11	(2)(A) The fire department shall submit an annual report to the
12	Arkansas Department of Emergency Management.
13	(B) The annual report described in subdivision (f)(2)(A)
14	of this section shall be filed by January 31 of each year.
15	(g) The program shall expire on July 1, 2021, unless it is continued
16	by the General Assembly.
