5	Arkansas Entertainers Hall of Fame Board
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8	13-9-101. Members Meetings.
9	(a) There is created and established the Arkansas Entertainers Hall of
10	Fame Board.
11	(b)(1) The board shall be composed of eleven (11) voting members, nine
12	(9) of whom shall be appointed by the Governor for terms of six (6) years
13	each.
14	(2) Two (2) members shall be appointed by the Governor from each
15	congressional district in the state, and one (1) shall be appointed at large.
16	(3)(A) Additionally, the Secretary of State shall be an ex
17	officio nonvoting member.
18	(B) The Speaker of the House of Representatives shall
19	appoint one (1) voting member to serve at the pleasure of the Speaker of the
20	House of Representatives.
21	(C) The President Pro Tempore of the Senate shall appoint
22	one (1) voting member to serve at the pleasure of the President Pro Tempore
23	of the Senate.
24	(D) In addition, the members of the board shall appoint
25	two (2) ex officio nonvoting members.
26	(4) Members of the board shall not be compensated for their
27	services, but each member may receive expense reimbursement in accordance
28	with § 25-16-902.
29	(c)(l) The voting members of the board shall select a chair and a vice
30	chair from among their own number,
31	(2) The board shall meet annually,
32	(3) A majority of the voting members shall constitute a quorum
33	for the transaction of business.
34	(d) There is transferred all authority, rights, powers, duties,
35	records, personnel, property, unexpended balances of appropriations,
36	allocations, or other funds, privileges, and jurisdiction in conformance with

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6	13-9-103. Functions and powers.
7	(a) It shall be the function and main purpose of the Arkansas
8	Entertainers Hall of Fame Board to honor those, living or dead, who, by
9	achievement or service, have made outstanding and lasting contributions to
10	entertainment in Arkansas or elsewhere, by annually selecting Arkansas
11	entertainers for induction into the Arkansas Entertainers Hall of Fame.
12	(b) It shall also be the responsibility of the board to plan and
13	supervise the annual ceremony for the induction of Arkansas entertainers into
14	the Arkansas Entertainers Hall of Fame.
15	(c) The board may adopt appropriate rules and regulations concerning
16	the procedures to be followed in selecting inductees.

18	13-9-104. Donations.
19	(a) The Department of Parks and Tourism may solicit and accept
20	donations, contributions, and gifts of money and property to be used for the
21	support of the Arkansas Entertainers Hall of Fame program,
22	(b) All property, money, income, and resources of the department
23	received for support of the program shall be exempt from taxation, and all
24	gifts made to the department shall be tax exempt.
