27	(a) The General	Assembly finds that recent resi	dential development in

30	(b) The purpose	of this act is to assess and im	prove permitting and

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33	SECTION 2. DO NO	T CODIFY. <u>Definition.</u>	
34	As used in this a	act, "nonmunicipal domestic sewa	ige treatment works"
35	means a device or syste	em operated by an entity other t	:han a city, town,
36	county, or sewer improv	vement district that treats, in	whole or in part, waste

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1	or wastewater from humans or household operations and must continuously		
2	operate to protect human health and the environment despite a permittee's		
3	failure to maintain or operate the device or system.

5	Section 3. DO NOT CODIFY. Nonmunicipal Sewage Treatment Works Task		
6	Force — Creation — Duties.		
7	(a) The Nonmunicipal Sewage Treatment Works Task Force is created.		
8	(b) The task force shall consist of the following five (5) members:		
9	(1) The Director of the Arkansas Department of Environmental		
10	Quality or the director's designee;		
11	(2) Two (2) members appointed by the Governor;		
12	(3) The Director of the Department of Health or the director's		
13	designee; and		
14	(4) A representative of the Arkansas Environmental Federation.		
15	(b) The Arkansas Department of Environmental Quality shall support the		
16	task force's efforts by scheduling the meetings of the task force, hosting		
17	the meetings of the task force, and providing the required notice and		
18	compliance under the Freedom of Information Act of 1967, § 25-19-101 et seq.		
19	(c) The task force shall:		
20	(1) Hold two (2) public meetings to receive oral and written		
21	public comment while satisfying the following terms:		
22	(A) The first public meeting of the task force shall be		
23	held as soon as practicable after the membership appointments are complete;		
24	<u>and</u>		
25	(B)(i) The task force shall issue a draft report after the		
26	first public meeting.		
27	(ii) After the release of the draft report, the task		
28	force shall hold a second public meeting regarding the draft report; and		
29	(2) Prepare a report for submission to Legislative Council on or		
30	before December 31, 2017.		
31	(d) The task force report required under subdivision (c)(2) of this		
32	section shall:		
33	(1) Contain a summary of task force meetings, deliberations, and		
34	comments received;		
35	(2) Address task force findings pertaining to the following		
36	topics and nonmunicipal domestic servage treatment works.		

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1	(A) Location;
2	(B) Number of homes served;
3	(C) Permittee and owner requirements and qualifications;
4	(D) Size, flow, and quality of receiving streams;
5	(E) Wastewater operator training and qualifications; and
6	(F) Other topics as agreed to by the task force upon a
7	majority vote; and
8	(3) Propose a model regulation that, if adopted, implements the
9	findings and recommendations of the task force.
10	(e)(1) Within thirty (30) days after the task force submits its report
11	to Legislative Council, the Arkansas Department of Environmental Quality
12	shall petition the Arkansas Pollution Control and Ecology Commission to
13	initiate rulemaking to adopt the model regulation.
14	(2) Existing law and administrative procedure shall govern the
15	rulemaking process.
16	(f) This section expires one (1) year after the effective date of this
17	<u>act.</u>
