19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
20

21 *SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 12, Chapter 12, Subchapter 1, is*
22 *amended to add an additional section to read as follows:*

23 *12-12-110. Criminal justice data collection.*

24 *(a) A state or local law enforcement agency that employs a law*
25 *enforcement officer who is involved in a law enforcement officer-involved*
26 *shooting that results in a person suspected of criminal activity being shot*
27 *at by the law enforcement officer shall report the following information to*
28 *the Department of Arkansas State Police:*

29 *(1) If known, the age, gender, sexual orientation, race,*
30 *ethnicity, and medically documented physical or mental disability of the*
31 *person suspected of criminal activity;*

32 *(2) If known, the age, gender, race, and ethnicity of the law*
33 *enforcement officer;*

34 *(3) The law enforcement officer's basis for the contact or stop*
35 *that led to the law enforcement officer-involved shooting;*

36 *(4) The law enforcement officer's basis for the shooting;*



1 (5) Whether the law enforcement officer or any other law
2 enforcement officer responding to the scene conducted a search and, if so,
3 whether the search was conducted with probable cause, with consent, or under
4 any other lawful exception to the warrant requirement, and whether contraband
5 was found and, if so, the nature of the contraband;

6 (6) Whether the law enforcement officer or any other law
7 enforcement officer responding to the scene issued a verbal warning before
8 shooting; and

9 (7) Whether the law enforcement officer or any other law
10 enforcement officer responding to the scene arrested or issued a citation to
11 a person and, if so, the offenses charged as a result of the arrest or
12 citation.

13 (b)(1) The department shall compile and report the data collected
14 under subsection (a) of this section by December 1, 2017, and by December 1
15 of every year thereafter.

16 (2) The data compiled and the report under subdivision (b)(1) of
17 this section shall be reported to the Chair of the House Committee on
18 Judiciary and the Chair of the Senate Committee on Judiciary.
