22	WHEREAS, Arkansas is richly endowed with natural resources and provides
23	limitless opportunities for both commercial and recreational activities; and
24	
25	WHEREAS, the overall economic viability of the state has been directly
26	impacted by the state and federal commitment to provide accessibility to
27	specific areas with improved roads and highways; and
28	
29	WHEREAS, while the southeastern part of Arkansas extending from McGehee
30	down through El Dorado has much to offer, many of the communities in that
31	area are experiencing a decline in economic prosperity that threatens to make
32	those communities irrelevant as business and tourist destinations as a direct
33	result of the limited commercial and recreational traffic through the area;

36	WHEREAS, improving road and highway accessibility to the southeastern



1	part of the state by expanding the United States Route 69 north-south
2	corridor will create economic prosperity for the Arkansas communities that
3	extend along the corridor, as well as supporting and encouraging multistate
4	transportation development throughout the Delta region as a whole,
5	
6	NOW THEREFORE,
7	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE NINETY-FIRST GENERAL
8	ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:
9	
10	THAT the General Assembly recognizes the need for expansion of the
11	United States Route 69 north-south corridor and encourages the United States
12	Government to fund a project to provide accessibility to and create economic
13	prosperity for the Arkansas communities extending along the corridor.
14	
15	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT upon adoption of this resolution, an appropriate
16	copy shall be provided to the Arkansas congressional delegation by the Chief
17	Clerk of the House of Representatives.
