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20	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE NINETY-FIRST GENERAL
21	ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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23	SECTION 1. Section 38.(n) of the Rules of the House of Representatives
24	of the Ninety-First General Assembly of the State of Arkansas is amended to
25	read as follows:
26	38. (n) <u>(a)</u> The Joint Committee on Constitutional Amendments shall
27	consist of the members of the Senate Committee on State Agencies and
28	Governmental Affairs and the members of the House Committee on State Agencies
29	and Governmental Affairs. No proposed constitutional amendment can be
30	recommended to either House of the General Assembly except upon the
31	affirmative vote of a majority of the members of the Senate Committee on
32	State Agencies and Governmental Affairs and an affirmative vote of a majority
33	of the members of the House Committee on State Agencies and Governmental
34	Affairs. No resolution proposing a constitutional amendment shall be filed
35	in either the House of Representatives or the Senate after the thirty-first
36	(31st) day of each regular session of the General Assembly. <u>Proposed</u>



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1	constitutional amendments may only be considered during regular sessions.
2	<u>38. (n)(b)</u> All resolutions proposing constitutional amendments shall
3	be referred to the $\frac{\text{Joint }}{\text{House}}$ Committee on State Agencies and Governmental
4	Affairs, which by an affirmative vote of its members may recommend proposals
5	one-at-a-time to the House of Representatives for its consideration. Other
6	resolutions proposing constitutional amendments shall not be reported to or
7	considered by either House of the General Assembly until the original
8	recommendations of the Joint Committee on State Agencies and Covernmental
9	Affairs are disposed of. A resolution proposing a constitutional amendment
10	may be considered only during a regular session. The Joint Committee on
11	Constitutional Amendments shall meet on the first (lst) Tuesday after the
12	thirty-first (31st) day of each regular session of the General Assembly to
13	establish a meeting calendar and meet regularly thereafter.
14	38. (n)(c) Any proposed constitutional amendment initiated in and
15	approved by the House of Representatives shall be transmitted to the Senate
16	for its consideration. If the Senate fails to approve a House-proposed
17	constitutional amendment, the House of Representatives may proceed to
18	initiate other proposed constitutional amendments one-at-a-time for Senate
19	consideration.
20	38. (n)(d) Any proposed constitutional amendment received from the
21	Senate shall be referred to the House Committee on State Agencies and
22	Governmental Affairs, which by an affirmative vote of its members may
23	recommend the proposal to the House of Representatives for its consideration.
24	38. (n)(e) Upon adoption by the General Assembly of a House-proposed
25	constitutional amendment and a Senate-proposed constitutional amendment, in
26	accordance with the Joint Rules, a third proposed constitutional amendment
27	may be considered and voted upon by the General Assembly only after identical
28	resolutions authorizing the consideration of the third proposed
29	constitutional amendment have been approved by an affirmative vote of two-
30	thirds (2/3) of the members elected to each house.
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
