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22	WHEREAS, neurofibromatosis, or NF, is a genetic disorder characterized
23	by the growth of tumors on nerves; and
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25	WHEREAS, there are three (3) types of NF, including NF1, NF2, and
26	schwannomatosis; and the most common type is NF1, also called Von
27	Recklinghausen's disease, which is estimated to affect one (1) in every three
28	thousand (3,000) people throughout the world; and

30	WHEREAS, NF may affect anyone, regardless of family history, race,
31	gender, or ethnicity; and
32	INTERESC complications of NE may include severe pain have
33 34	WHEREAS, complications of NF may include severe pain, bone
35	abnormalities, blindness, deafness, and cancer; and
36	WHEREAS, NF1 is usually diagnosed in childhood; and

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2	WHEREAS, Zayden Smith of Greenbrier, Arkansas, was diagnosed with NFl
3	when he was only three (3) months old; and
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5	WHEREAS, when Zayden was fifteen (15) months old, in November 2015, he
6	had his first MRI, which revealed an optic pathway glioma on his left optic
7	nerve; and
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9	WHEREAS, a subsequent scan was performed three (3) months later in
10	February 2016, which showed some signs of regression, and Zayden's physicians
11	decided to scan the area again in six (6) months; and
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13	WHEREAS, in August 2016, an MRI revealed that Zayden had an optic
14	pathway glioma on both his left and right eyes and one on the chiasm where
15	the optic nerves meet, threatening Zayden's vision; and
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17	WHEREAS, Zayden and his family were advised by his physicians to
18	implement a treatment plan due to the aggressive nature of the tumors; and
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20	WHEREAS, the treatment plan includes weekly chemotherapy treatments at
21	the Arkansas Children's Hospital for a year, the treatment ending in
22	September 2017; and
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24	WHEREAS, Zayden will undergo another scan three (3) months post-
25	treatment to detect any growth of the tumors; and
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27	WHEREAS, Zayden has demonstrated bravery and resilience as he continues
28	to battle this genetic disorder; and
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30	WHEREAS, Zayden's parents, Matt and Phaylan Davis, and grandparents, Jo
31	and Larry Davis and Gregg and Janette Clements, have given constant support
32	and dedication during Zayden's treatment,
