26	WHEREAS, Arkansas is richly endowed with natural resources and provides
27	limitless opportunities for both commercial and recreational activities; and
28	
29	WHEREAS, the overall economic viability of the state has been directly
30	impacted by the state and federal commitment to provide accessibility to
31	specific areas with improved roads and highways; and
32	
33	WHEREAS, in contrast, while the western part of Arkansas extending from
34	Fort Smith to Texarkana has much to offer, many of the communities in that
35	area are experiencing a decline in economic prosperity that threatens to make
36	those communities irrelevant as business and tourist destinations as a direct



1	result of the limited commercial and recreational traffic through the area;
2	and

4	WHEREAS, improving road and highway accessibility to the western part
5	of the state by expanding the United States Route 49 north-south corridor
6	will not only serve to create economic prosperity for the Arkansas
7	communities that extend along the corridor, but also will contribute to the
8	overall economic prosperity of the entire state,
9	
10	NOW THEREFORE,
11	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE NINETY-FIRST GENERAL
12	ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
13	
14	THAT the House of Representatives recognize the need for expansion of
15	the United States Route 49 north-south corridor and encourage the United
16	States Government to fund a project to provide accessibility to and create
17	economic prosperity for the Arkansas communities extending along the
18	corridor.

20	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT upon adoption of this resolution, an appropriate
21	copy shall be provided to the Arkansas congressional delegation by the Chief
22	Clerk of the House of Representatives.
