8	PROMOTING THE AWARENESS OF PEDIATRIC ACUTE-ONSET

16	ACUTE-ONSET NEUROPSYCHIATRIC SYNDROME AND
17	PEDIATRIC AUTOIMMUNE NEUROPSYCHIATRIC
18	DISORDER ASSOCIATED WITH STREPTOCOCCAL
19	INFECTIONS.

22	WHEREAS, Pediatric Acute-onset Neuropsychiatric Syndrome, also known as
23	"PANS", is a clinically defined disorder characterized by the sudden onset of
24	obsessive-compulsive symptoms or eating restrictions, accompanied by two (2)
25	or more symptoms of acute behavioral deterioration or motor and sensory
26	changes, or both; and
27	
28	WHEREAS, Pediatric Autoimmune Neuropsychiatric Disorder Associated with
29	Streptococcal Infections, also known as "PANDAS", is a term used to describe
30	a subset of children and adolescents within the broader PANS classification
31	who have obsessive compulsive disorder (OCD) or tic disorders, and in whom
32	symptoms worsen following streptococcal infections such as strep sore throat
33	and scarlet fever; and
34	
35	WHEREAS, PANS and PANDAS were identified in 2012 by Dr. Susan Swedo;
36	and as doctors are not required to report the number of patients suffering



1	with these disorders, the true number of affected individuals is unknown; and
2	
3	
4	WHEREAS, the plight of children with PANS and PANDAS requires increased
5	awareness, knowledge, and treatment throughout the state, especially among
6	healthcare professionals,
7	
8	NOW THEREFORE,
9	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE NINETY-FIRST GENERAL
10	ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
11	
12	THAT the House of Representatives recognize Pediatric Acute-onset
13	Neuropsychiatric Syndrome and Pediatric Autoimmune Neuropsychiatric Disorder
14	Associated with Streptococcal Infections, encourage the promotion of
15	awareness of the disorders, and proclaim October 9 of each year as PANS and
16	PANDAS Awareness Day.
17	
18	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT upon adoption of this resolution, a copy shall be
19	provided to the Director of the Department of Health by the Chief Clerk of
20	the House of Representatives.
