18	WHEREAS, World War II was the 2nd global conflict of the 20 th Century
19	and lasted from 1939 to 1945; and
20	
21	WHEREAS, the war was initiated by Nazi Germany in an attempt to conquer
22	Europe under the leadership of Adolf Hitler and is widely believed to be the
23	most bloody conflict in human history, with the total casualty estimation of
24	military and civilian losses at over 73,000,000 people; and
25	INTERPRESSOR AND ADDRESS OF THE STATE OF THE
26 27	WHEREAS, the world still feels the shock of the brutality of this war,
27 28	as the realities of state-sponsored mass genocide, nuclear warfare, and
20 29	streamlined propaganda campaigns were fully realized in this short period; and
30	and
31	WHEREAS, the United States entered the war on December 7, 1941, after a
32	kamikaze attack on the United States Naval Base at Pearl Harbor, Hawaii; and
33	Name and the control states have but four margor, manari, and
34	WHEREAS, United States troops were integral in combating the Imperial
35	Japanese Army and Navy in the Asian-Pacific Theater, in the retaking of
36	France from the Nazi Wehrmacht in the European Theater, in the freeing of



T	German and Polish political prisoners, and in the denazilication of Germany;

4	WHEREAS, as of 2016, there are an estimated 5,340 veterans of the war
5	living in Arkansas; and
6	
7	WHEREAS, Mr. James Donald Neal Burnett is one of those veterans who
8	served in the United States Navy from 1943 until 1946 as a motor machinist's
9	mate third class on the USS Oak Hill LSD 7; and Mr. Burnett was involved in
10	the American Campaign, the Asiatic-Pacific Campaign, and the Philippine
11	Liberation Campaign,
12	
13	NOW THEREFORE,
14	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE NINETY-FIRST GENERAL
15	ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
16	
17	THAT the House of Representatives honor the courage, dedication, and
18	bravery of the veterans of World War II, and specifically thank Mr. James
19	Donald Neal Burnett for his service to this state and to this country.
20	
21	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT upon adoption of this resolution, a copy shall be
22	transmitted to Mr. Burnett by the Chief Clerk of the House of
23	Representatives.
