36	(3) <u>(A)</u> "4	Athletic trainer" means a person lice	nsed by the state



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1	to engage in athletic training under the supervision of a licensed physician.
2	(B) An "athletic trainer" is an allied healthcare
3	professional;
4	(4) "Athletic training" means the prevention, recognition,
5	evaluation, treatment, and rehabilitation of, and emergency care and use of
6	appropriate preventative and supportive devices for, an athletic injury or
7	illness and the organization and administration of exercise, conditioning,
8	and athletic training programs and the emergency care and treatment of an
9	athletic injury or illness during a non-sanctioned recreational sport
10	activity on the day of the activity except when the injury is a concussion
11	which may require a continuum of healthcare;
12	(5) "Board" means the Arkansas State Board of Athletic Training;
13	(6) "Direct supervision" means supervision of the athletic
14	trainer in a clinical setting in which the supervising physical therapist
15	must be readily available for consultation for the care of the athlete but
16	not necessarily on the premises supervisor is on-site and readily available
17	to intervene on behalf of the patient and provide consultation to the
18	<u>athletic trainer;</u>
19	(7) <u>(A) "Indirect supervision" means supervision of the athletic</u>
20	trainer in a nonclinical setting in which the supervising physician is not
21	required to be on-site, but is readily available for consultation via radio,
22	telephone, fax, email, or other accepted forms of communication.
23	(B) "Indirect supervision" shall be demonstrated by a
24	<u>standing order;</u>
25	(8) "License" means the document issued by the board to a
26	qualified person to practice athletic training; and
27	(8) (9) "Sanctioned recreational sports activities" means any
28	athletic or team activity which requires physical strength, agility,
29	flexibility, range of motion, speed, or stamina and meets one (1) or more of
30	the following:
31	(A) Has officially designated coaches who have the
32	responsibility for athletic activities of the organization;
33	(B) Has a regular schedule of practices or workouts which
34	are supervised by the officially designated coaches;
35	(C) Is an activity generally recognized as having an
36	established schedule of competitive events or exhibitions; and

1	(D) Has a policy requiring documentation of having passed
2	a preparticipation medical examination conducted by a licensed physician as a
3	condition for participation for the athletic activities of the organization;
4	and
5	(10)(A) "Standing order" means a written agreement developed in
6	<u>conjunction with one (1) or more supervising physicians that identifies</u>
7	protocols or procedures that the athletic trainer may perform and is signed
, 8	by the supervising physician and the licensed athletic trainer.
9	<u>(B) "Standing order" includes without limitation:</u>
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10	<i>(i) The manner and frequency in which the athletic</i> <i>trainer regularly communicates with the supervising physician;</i>
11	
12	(ii) The appropriate interventions for specific
15	athlete injuries and illnesses;
	(iii) The appropriate conditions for the immediate
15	referral and subsequent referral to a licensed healthcare provider of injured
16	or ill athletes;
17	<u>(iv) The physician's designation of another</u>
18	supervising physician for instances when the supervising physician is not
19 20	<u>readily available; and</u>
20	(v) The consultation of supervising physician for
21	<u>continuity of care when the athlete is under the care of a physician who is</u>
22	not the supervising physician of the athletic trainer.
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24 25	17-93-403. Penalties.
25	(a) (1) Any <u>A</u> person who violates a provision of this subchapter is
26	guilty of a misdemeanor punishable by a fine of not less than one hundred
27	dollars (\$100) nor more than five hundred dollars (\$500) or by imprisonment
28	for not less than thirty (30) days nor more than one hundred eighty (180)
29	days, or both.
30	(2) Each day of a violation constitutes a separate offense.
31	(b)(1) After notice and hearing, the Arkansas State Board of Athletic
32	Training is also authorized to may levy a civil penalty against any:
33	(A) person Person licensed under the provisions of this
34	subchapter after a finding that the person has violated any of the provisions
35	of this subchapter or any regulations <u>rule</u> promulgated by the board; <u>and</u>
36	(B) Unlicensed person practicing or offering to practice

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1	any actions requiring licensure pursuant to the provisions of this
2	subchapter.
3	(2) Each day a violation occurs shall constitute a separate
4	offense.
5	(c) Civil penalties <u>A civil penalty</u> assessed by the board shall be no
6	more than one thousand dollars (\$1,000) per incident.
7	(d) In addition to any other sanctions authorized by this subchapter,
8	the board may impose a civil penalty as provided in this section against any
9	unlicensed person practicing or offering to practice any actions requiring
10	licensure pursuant to the provisions of this subchapter.
11	(d) This subchapter does not limit the authority of or prohibit a
12	person licensed under any other law in this state from engaging in the
13	practice for which he or she is licensed.
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15	SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 17-93-406 is amended to read as follows:
16	17-93-406. Powers and duties of the board.
17	(a) The Arkansas State Board of Athletic Training shall have the
18	following powers and duties to:
19	(1) To receive <u>Receive</u> and maintain all records of board
20	proceedings;
21	(2) To adopt <u>Adopt</u> minimum curriculum and internship
22	requirements for qualification for an Arkansas athletic trainer's license;
23	(3) To issue <u>Issue</u> licenses;
24	(4) To keep <u>Keep</u> a complete record of all licensed athletic
25	trainers, including:
26	(A) Preparing annually a roster showing the names and
27	addresses of all licensed athletic trainers; and
28	(B) Making available a copy of such a <u>the</u> roster to any
29	person requesting it on payment of a fee as established by the board to cover
30	the cost of the roster;
31	(5) To adopt <u>Adopt</u> rules and regulations consistent with this
32	subchapter which are necessary for the performance of its duties, including,
33	but not limited to, the imposing of fees adequate to carry out the purposes
34	of this subchapter;
35	(6) To collect <u>Collect</u> fees adequate to carry out the purposes
36	of this subchapter;

1	(7) To keep <u>Keep</u> records of fees collected and costs incurred
2	for operations of the board and licensing of athletic trainers; and
3	(8) To file <u>File</u> an annual report of its activities, including
4	the activities of the board, with the Department of Finance and
5	Administration.
6	(b) In addition to the powers and duties set forth in this subchapter,
7	the board shall investigate reported violations of this subchapter and take
8	necessary steps to enforce this subchapter.
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10	SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 17-93-407(b), concerning exceptions to
11	licensure as an athletic trainer, is amended to read as follows:
12	(b) Nothing in this This subchapter shall be construed to does not:
13	(1) Authorize the practice of medicine or physical therapy by
14	any person not so licensed by the state;
15	(2) Prohibit the lawful practice of a licensed health care
16	professional under the scope of his or her license;
17	(3) Prohibit the lawful practice of a licensed athletic trainer
18	from another state who accompanies his or her team, athlete, or
19	representatives to the State of Arkansas for limited competition; or
20	(4) Prohibit designated interns from university academic
21	programs preparing athletic trainers from performing acts of athletic
22	training incidental to their courses of study <u>; or</u>
23	(5) Prohibit a person in an entry-level professional education
24	program that is approved by the Arkansas State Board of Athletic Training
25	from performing acts of athletic training to satisfy supervised clinical
26	education requirements related to the education of the person.
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28	SECTION 4. Arkansas Code §§ 17-93-409 — 17-93-413 are amended to read
29	as follows:
30	17-93-409. Qualification — Athletic trainer.
31	(a) For the purpose of this subchapter, a person is actively engaged
32	as an athletic trainer if the person has performed such duties as a principal
33	part of his or her full-time employment under the direction of a licensed
34	physician for three (3) of the past five (5) years preceding the application.
35	(b)<u>(</u>a) An applicant for an Arkansas athletic trainer's license must <u>is</u>
36	required to:

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1	(1) Possess <u>at least</u> a bachelor's degree from an accredited
2	college or university;
3	(2) Meet other <u>athletic training</u> curriculum and internship
4	requirements as specified <u>established</u> by the Arkansas State Board of Athletic
5	Training;
6	(3) Pass an examination for licensure as designated by the board
7	which is a reliable, valid, legally defensible examination for determining
8	minimum competency in athletic training;
9	(4) Submit appropriate application forms to the board; and
10	(5) Pay all appropriate fees.
11	(c) Notarized proof of employment, performance of duties, and
12	supervision shall accompany the person's application.
13	(d)(b) Anyone A person who meets the qualifications prescribed in
14	subsection (b) (a) of this section, except for the examination requirement
15	under subdivision $(b)(3)$ (a)(3) of this section, shall be issued a temporary
16	nonrenewable <u>athletic</u> trainer's permit <u>license</u> which shall expire one (1)
17	year <u>six (6) months</u> after the date of application therefor .
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19	17-93-410. Expiration and renewal.
20	(a) A license issued under this subchapter expires one (1) year after
21	the date of issuance on June 30th of each calendar year.
22	(b) <u>(1)</u> Licenses <u>A license</u> shall be renewed according to procedures
23	established by the Arkansas State Board of Athletic Training.
24	(2) The board shall renew a license upon proof of
25	recertification as a certified athletic trainer provided by the athletic
26	trainers' national governing entity which shall include:
27	(A) Compliance with the standard of professional practice;
28	(B) Emergency cardiac care certification;
29	(C) Maintenance of fees; and
30	(D) Successful completion of continuing education
31	requirements as determined by the board.
32	
33	17-93-411. Direction and supervision Physician supervision.
34	(a) In a nonclinical setting, an An athletic trainer may practice the
35	art and science of athletic training under the direction <u>supervision</u> of a
36	physician licensed in the State of Arkansas.

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1	(b) The athletic trainer may practice athletic training in a hospital
2	or outpatient clinic under the direct supervision of a physical therapist and
3	upon the referral of a physician licensed in the State of Arkansas In a
4	nonclinical setting, an athletic trainer shall practice the art and science
5	of athletic training under the indirect supervision of a physician who is
6	<u>licensed in the State of Arkansas</u> .
7	(c)(1) In a clinical setting, an athletic trainer shall practice the
8	art and science of athletic training under the direct supervision of:
9	(A) A physician; or
10	(B) A physical therapist when the athletic trainer is
11	working in a physical therapy clinic.
12	(2) An athletic trainer shall practice athletic training in a
13	clinical setting upon the referral of a physician.
14	
15	17-93-412. Revocation, suspension, or denial — Grounds.
16	(a) The Arkansas State Board of Athletic Training may refuse to issue
17	or renew a license or <u>may</u> suspend or revoke a license if an applicant <u>or</u>
18	licensee has:
19	(1) Been convicted of a felony or misdemeanor involving moral
20	turpitude, the record of conviction being conclusive evidence of conviction
21	if the board determines after investigation that the person has not been
22	sufficiently rehabilitated to warrant the public trust;
23	(2) Secured a license under this subchapter by fraud or deceit;
24	OT
25	(3) Violated or conspired to violate this subchapter or rules or
26	regulations issued pursuant to <u>under</u> this subchapter <u>;</u>
27	(4) Been found guilty of unethical or unprofessional conduct, as
28	determined by the board;
29	(5) Been convicted of a violation of any state or federal
30	narcotics laws;
31	(6) Been habitually intoxicated or has been addicted to the use
32	<u>of narcotic drugs;</u>
33	(7) Been found guilty of gross negligence in his or her
34	practice, as determined by the board;
35	(8) Been convicted of sexual abuse or sexual misconduct; or
36	(9) Been declared incompetent by a court and has not thereafter

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1 been lawfully declared competent. 2 (b)(1) On application, the board may reissue a license to a person 3 whose license has been revoked, but the application may not be made prior to 4 before the expiration of a period of one (1) year after the order of 5 revocation has become final. 6 (2) Such The application shall be made in the manner and form required by the board. 7 8 9 17-93-413. Revocation, suspension, or denial - Proceedings. 10 (a) Any person whose application for a license or for renewal of a 11 license is denied is entitled to a hearing, which shall be conducted pursuant 12 to under the Arkansas Administrative Procedure Act, § 25-15-201 et seq. 13 (b)(1) Proceedings for revocation or suspension of a license shall be 14 commenced by filing charges with the Arkansas State Board of Athletic 15 Training in writing. 16 (2) The charge may be brought by any person against a person 17 having a license to practice as an athletic trainer in this state charging 18 that the person has committed a violation under § 17-93-412. 19 (3)(A) The board shall send an advisory notice to the person who 20 allegedly committed a violation once the complaint has been received by the 21 board. 22 (B) The advisory notice shall include a statement 23 notifying the person who allegedly committed a violation that the person 24 shall reply to the notice. 25 (c) The board shall fix the time and place of the hearing and shall 26 provide a written copy of the charges or reason for the denial of the license 27 or for the refusal to renew the license, together with a notice of the time 28 and place fixed for the hearing, to be served on the applicant requesting the 29 hearing or license against whom the charges have been filed at least thirty 30 (30) days prior to before the date set for the hearing. 31 32 SECTION 5. Arkansas Code Title 17, Chapter 93, Subchapter 4, is 33 amended to add an additional section to read as follows: 17-93-415.
