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SECTION 6. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 2 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. EMPLOYEE 3 4 DEVELOPMENT INCENTIVES. In order to increase the adult degree completion rate 5 and to develop its own human capital, Arkansas State University System is 6 hereby authorized to offer one time lump-sum incentive bonuses or educational 7 differentials of up to six percent (6%) of the employee's salary for degree 8 attainment. A bonus or compensation differential may not be authorized if the 9 education is included as a special requirement or minimum qualification 10 established for the classification by the official class specification. 11 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2016 12 2017 through June 30, 2017 2018.

Disbursement of funds 27 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency 28 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and 29 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and 30 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary 31 Procedures and Restrictions Act, the Higher Education Expenditures 32 Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this 33 State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of 34 Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied 35 with in disbursement of said funds.

1 SECTION 9. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General 2 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for 3 4 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive 5 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget 6 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or 7 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative 8 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption. 9

SECTION 10. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the

General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits
the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the

13 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2017 is essential to the operation of

14 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in

15 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the

16 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2017 could work irreparable harm

17 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental

18 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act

19 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health

- 20 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2017.
