9	SECTION 3. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the		
10	General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that the operations of the Arkansas		
11	Teacher Retirement System are complex; that the system must be able to meet		
12	the needs of its members as anticipated by the General Assembly; that certain		
13	provisions of the Arkansas Teacher Retirement System Act are imminently in		
14	need of revision and updating to bring them into conformance with sound		
15	public pension policy and actuarial requirements; that such revision and		
16	updating is of great importance to members of the system and to other		
17	citizens of the State of Arkansas; that the system needs to have the ability		
18	to make immediate changes to maintain and improve its actuarial status; and		
19	that this act is immediately necessary in order to maintain an orderly		
20	management of benefits for the members of the system. Therefore, an emergency		
21	is declared to exist, and this act being immediately necessary for the		
22	preservation of the public peace, health, and safety shall become effective		
23	on:		
24	(1) The date of its approval by the Governor;		
25	(2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor,		
26	the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the		
27	bill; or		
28	(3) If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is		
29	overridden, the date the last house overrides the veto.
