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1 (2) The county board of election commissioners shall also file 2 in the office of the clerk of the county court a certificate setting forth in 3 detail the results of the election.

4 (c)(1) In the event that If no candidate for mayor of a city of the 5 first class receives a majority the requisite amount of the votes cast in the 6 general election, the two (2) candidates receiving the highest number of 7 votes shall be certified to a special runoff election that shall be held 8 three (3) weeks from the day on which the general election is held.

9 (2) The special runoff election shall be conducted in the same 10 manner as provided by law, and the election results thereof of the special 11 <u>runoff election</u> shall be canvassed and certified in the manner provided by 12 law.

13 (d) In the event that If a vacancy occurs in the office of mayor of 14 these cities a city described in this section and the unexpired term is more 15 than one (1) year, the vacancy shall be filled by a special election and 16 special runoff election, if necessary, as provided in subsection (c) of this 17 section.

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
