27	SECTION 1. Ar	kansas Code § 24-5-119(b), concerning r	edetermination of
28	benefits under the Arkansas State Highway Employees' Retirement System, is

2	SECTION 2. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General		
3	Assembly of the State of Arkansas that the law prohibits a publicly supporte		
4	retirement system from implementing a benefit enhancement if it would cause		
5	the publicly supported retirement system's unfunded actuarial accrued		
6	liabilities to exceed a thirty-year amortization; that the law prohibits \underline{a}		
7	publicly supported system from implementing a benefit enhancement if it has		
8	unfunded actuarial accrued liabilities being amortized over a period		
9	exceeding thirty (30) years until the unfunded actuarial accrued liability is		
10	reduced to a level less than the standards prescribed by law; that the		
11	Arkansas State Highway Employees' Retirement System uses a general life		
12	expectancy table; and that the current method of redetermining benefits will		
13	cause the retirement system's unfunded actuarial accrued liabilities to		
14	exceed a thirty-year amortization if not immediately resolved by increasing		
15	the system's assets and reducing its unfunded liabilities. Therefore, an		
16	emergency is declared to exist, and this act being necessary for the		
17	preservation of the public peace, health, and safety shall become effective		
18	on and after July 1, 2017.
