8	the State Health Department Building and Local Grant Trust Fund.		
9	(B) Any funds derived from the collection of client visit		
10	fees in excess of six hundred thousand dollars (\$600,000) in any fiscal year		
11	shall be transferred to the Public Health Fund by the Chief Fiscal Officer of
