- 22 classification (RN, LPN/LPTN, BHA/CNA) for up to 24 hours per week per
- 23 individual. This will allow the Division to offer weekend option shifts to
- 24 nursing personnel without increasing the number of positions.
- 25 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2016
- 26 <u>2017</u> through June 30, <del>2017</del> 2018.

- 28 SECTION 15. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
- 29 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.
- 30 BEHAVIORAL HEALTH SERVICES STATE HOSPITAL CONTINGENCY POSITIONS. If the
- 31 Department of Human Services determines, and after prior review by the
- 32 Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee, it shall be determined that it
- 33 is in the best interest of the State of Arkansas to discontinue a management
- 34 contract with a private provider and it is deemed necessary to utilize
- 35 Department staff to provide the required services, the Director of the
- 36 Department of Human Services may request the Department of Finance and

- 1 Administration to approve the establishment of one or more additional
- 2 positions at salary rates not to exceed the maximum salaries established for
- 3 comparable positions in the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, the
- 4 Department of Human Services' Appropriation Act, and the University of
- 5 Arkansas for Medical Sciences' Appropriation Act. Upon approval by the
- 6 Department of Finance and Administration and after review by the Legislative
- 7 Council or Joint Budget Committee, the Department of Human Services -
- 8 Division of Behavioral Health Services may establish such positions.
- 9 If the agency requests continuation of a "Growth Pool" position(s) as
- 10 established herein, the position(s) must be requested as a new position(s) in
- 11 the agency's budget request.
- 12 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1,  $\frac{2016}{1}$
- 13 2017 through June 30, <del>2017</del> 2018.

- 15 SECTION 16. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
- 16 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. ARKANSAS
- 17 HEALTH CENTER. (A) The Department of Human Services shall not close the
- 18 Arkansas Health Center that provides skilled nursing through specialized
- 19 services and programs.
- 20 (B) The Department of Human Services shall continue to accept clients for
- 21 whom it has determined that skilled nursing and specialized services are
- 22 needed at the Arkansas Health Center.
- 23 (C) No funds shall be transferred or reduced from the Arkansas Health
- 24 Center, except for use as federal matching funds, below the approved funding
- 25 level on March 1, 2003 without the prior approval of the Arkansas Legislative
- 26 Council or the Joint Budget Committee.
- 27 (D) Determining the maximum amount of appropriation and general revenue
- 28 funding for a state agency each fiscal year is the prerogative of the General
- 29 Assembly. This is usually accomplished by delineating such maximums in the
- 30 appropriation act(s) for a state agency and the general revenue allocations
- 31 authorized for each fund and fund account by amendment to the Revenue
- 32 Stabilization law. Further, the General Assembly has determined that the
- 33 Department of Human Services may operate more efficiently if some flexibility
- 34 is provided to the Department of Human Services authorizing broad powers
- 35 under this Section. Therefore, it is both necessary and appropriate that the
- 36 General Assembly maintain oversight by requiring prior approval of the

- 1 Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee as provided by this section.
- 2 The requirement of approval by the Legislative Council or Joint Budget
- 3 Committee is not a severable part of this section. If the requirement of
- 4 approval by the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee is ruled
- 5 unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, this entire section is
- 6 void.
- 7 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1,  $\frac{2016}{1}$
- 8 2017 through June 30, <del>2017</del> 2018.

- 10 SECTION 17. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
- 11 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. EXTRA
- 12 HELP BEHAVIORAL HEALTH SERVICES. Employees in extra-help positions at the
- 13 Department of Human Services Division of Behavioral Health Services may
- 14 receive an amount not to exceed eighty-five percent (85%) of the maximum
- 15 annual salary for a comparable position as authorized under § 21-5-201 et
- 16 seq. during any fiscal year, nor shall such an employee be employed for a
- 17 period of time to exceed one thousand eight hundred (1,800) hours in any
- 18 single fiscal year.
- The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2016
- 20 2017 through June 30, <del>2017</del> 2018.

- 22 SECTION 18. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
- 23 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.
- 24 BEHAVIORAL HEALTH SERVICES PROCEEDS FOR SALES OF TIMBER AND HAY CAPITAL
- 25 IMPROVEMENTS AND EQUIPMENT. The Division of Behavioral Health Services is
- 26 authorized to use the administrative operating account for capital
- 27 improvements to the physical plant, and for the purchase of capital
- 28 equipment, and for the operation of the Arkansas Health Center, operated by
- 29 the Department of Human Services Division of Behavioral Health Services.
- 30 The funds shall be held by the Department of Human Services Division of
- 31 Behavioral Health Services, from the proceeds of the sale of timber and hay
- 32 that may be harvested from land owned by the Division of Behavioral Health
- 33 Services. All funds deposited and all expenses shall be tracked separately.
- 34 The harvesting of timber and hay is specifically authorized to provide funds
- 35 to finance capital improvements to the physical plant, for the purchase of
- 36 major capital equipment, and for the operation of the Arkansas Health Center.

- 1 The Division of Behavioral Health Services shall report all income derived
- 2 from the sale of timber and hay to the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State and
- 3 the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee. Any contracts initiated
- 4 for the harvesting of timber and hay shall be submitted to the Review
- 5 Subcommittee of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee
- 6 for prior review. All expenditures of funds derived from the sale of timber
- 7 and hay will be expended in accordance with relevant state purchasing laws.
- 8 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1,  $\frac{2016}{1}$
- 9 <u>2017</u> through June 30, <del>2017</del> <u>2018</u>.

11 SECTION 19. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS

- 12 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. SPECIAL
- 13 RATES OF PAY AND EMPLOYMENT WORK DAYS. For employees hired on or after July
- 14 1, 2013, at the Arkansas State Hospital in the classifications listed below,
- 15 the Division of Behavioral Health Services Director shall implement salary
- 16 adjustments utilizing the approved pay grid for teachers employed by the
- 17 Arkansas Schools for the Blind and Deaf.
- 18 To achieve the salary adjustments, the Division of Behavioral Health
- 19 Services is authorized to pay special rates of pay for classifications at the
- 20 Arkansas State Hospital listed below:

- 24 Funding for the minimum compensation provided for in this section that
- 25 is supported in whole or in part from general revenues, shall, if required,
- 26 be provided by a transfer from the Merit Adjustment Fund to the proper fund
- 27 or fund account and in such amounts as determined by the Chief Fiscal Officer
- 28 of the State. The Division of Behavioral Health Services shall in addition
- 29 to the funds provided in this Act for Annual Career Service Recognition
- 30 Payments from the Merit Adjustment Fund, make available any funding generated
- 31 from agency salary savings for such purposes from the funds or fund accounts
- 32 as provided by law.
- For employees hired on or after July 1, 2013, at the Arkansas State
- 34 Hospital in the classifications listed above, the Division of Behavioral
- 35 Health Services Director shall set the number of work days for the employment
- 36 year to equal the number of days worked by those employed in the same

- l classifications at the Arkansas Schools for the Blind and Deaf. The accrual,
- 2 use, and carryover of sick days, personal days, and holidays of the employees
- 3 at the Arkansas State Hospital that are hired on or after July 1, 2013, or
- 4 current employees choosing to adopt this plan, shall be treated in the same
- 5 manner as those employed in the same classifications at the Arkansas Schools
- 6 for the Blind and Deaf.
- 7 Those currently employed at the Arkansas State Hospital in the
- 8 classifications listed above as of June 30, 2013, have the one-time option of
- 9 adopting this language or continuing to operate under the same salary, leave
- 10 and benefit plans they are currently receiving. Employees must make their
- 11 decision by June 30, 2013.
- Accrued annual and holiday leave, up to 240 hours, as of June 30,
- 13 2013, will be paid out to current employees choosing to adopt this plan. Any
- 14 additional accrued annual and holiday leave will be forfeited. Accrued sick
- 15 leave, as of June 30, 2013, shall be retained on file and shall be exhausted
- 16 before any newly accrued sick leave may be taken.
- 17 All employees affected by this section shall be eligible to receive
- 18 hazardous duty pay for time worked in eligible areas.
- The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2016
- 20 2017 through June 30, <del>2017</del> 2018.

- 22 SECTION 20. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
- 23 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
- 24 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and
- 25 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
- 26 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
- 27 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
- 28 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
- 29 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
- 30 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

- 32 SECTION 21. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
- 33 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
- 34 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
- 35 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
- 36 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget

1	manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
2	summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
3	Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.
4	
5	SECTION 22. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
6	General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits
7	the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
8	effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2017 is essential to the operation of
9	the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
10	the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the
11	effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2017 could work irreparable harm
12	upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
13	programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
14	being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
15	and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2017.
