21	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
22	
23	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 10, Chapter 2, Subchapter 1, is amended
24	to add an additional section to read as follows:
25	10-2-133. Racial impact statement.
26	(a)(1) A racial impact statement may be prepared as provided in this
27	section for any bill filed in the Senate or the House of Representatives that
28	<u>will:</u>
29	(A) Create a new misdemeanor or felony offense;
30	(B) Substantively change an element of an existing
31	misdemeanor or felony offense;
32	(C) Change the penalty for an existing misdemeanor or
33	felony offense; or
34	(D) Change existing sentencing, parole, or probation
35	procedures.
36	(2) A racial impact statement may be:

1	(A) Filed with the chair of a committee of the Senate or
2	the House of Representatives considering a bill under subdivision (a)(1) of
3	this section; and
4	(B) Shared with the members of a committee of the Senate
5	or House of the Representatives considering a bill under subdivision (a)(1)
6	of this section when the bill is considered.
7	(b)(1)(A) The Office of Economic and Tax Policy, with the assistance
8	of the University of Arkansas at Little Rock William H. Bowen School of Law
9	and with the faculty and students of the Arkansas Policy Program of Hendrix
10	College, shall prepare a racial impact statement under this section.
11	(B) The Arkansas Sentencing Commission, the Department of
12	Correction, the Department of Community Correction, the Administrative Office
13	of the Courts, and the Arkansas Crime Information Center shall cooperate
14	fully with the Office of Economic and Tax Policy, the University of Arkansas
15	at Little Rock William H. Bowen School of Law, and the faculty and students
16	of the Arkansas Policy Program of Hendrix College by providing data possessed
17	by those agencies that is requested to complete the racial impact statement
18	under this section.
19	(2) The racial impact statement shall include without
20	<u>limitation:</u>
21	(A) The estimated number of criminal cases per year that
22	the bill will affect;
23	(B) The impact of the bill on a minority group as defined
24	<u>in § 1-2-503;</u>
25	(C) The impact of the bill upon correctional facilities
26	and services; and
27	(D) Other matters deemed relevant to the bill at issue.
