24	SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 19-5-305(a)(2), concerning the Department		
25	of Career Education Public School Fund Account, is amended to read as		
26	follows:		
27	(2) Department of Career Education Public School Fund Account.		
28	The Department of Career Education Public School Fund Account shall be used		
29	for grants and aids for the programs administered by the Department of Caree		
30	Education consisting of, but not limited to:		
31	(A) General adult education grants;

6	(b) The fund shall consist of:	
7	(1) Moneys obtained from private grants or other sources that	
8	are designated to be credited to the fund; and	
9	(2) Ten percent (10%) of the sales tax revenues collected by the	
10	Department of Finance and Administration from the sale of usable marijuana	
11	under the Arkansas Medical Marijuana Amendment of 2016; and	
12	(3) Any other revenues as may be authorized by law.
