26	(a)(1) The Office of Health Information Technology is transferred to			
27	the Department of Health by a type 2 transfer under § 25-2-105.			
28	(2) For the purposes of this act, the Department of Health shall			
29	be considered a principal department established by Acts 1971, No. 38.			
30	(b) All authority,	(b) All authority, powers, duties, functions, records, personnel,		
31	property, unexpended balances of appropriations, allocations, and other			
32	funds, including the functions of budgeting or purchasing, are transferred to			
33	the Department of Health, except as specified by this act.			
34	(c) All powers, duties, and functions, including rulemaking,			
35	regulation, and licensing, promulgation of rules, rates, regulations, and			
36	standards, and the rendering of findings, orders, and adjudications are			



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1 transferred to the Director of the Department of Health. 2 (d) The members of the Health Information Exchange Council and their successors shall continue to be selected in the manner and serve for the 3 4 terms provided by the statutes applicable to the office except as specified 5 in this act. 6 (e) The Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall make appropriate name 7 changes in the Arkansas Code to implement this act. 8 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 25-42-101(2), concerning the purpose of the 9 10 Office of Health Information Technology, is amended to read as follows: 11 (2) Authorize the Office of Health Information Technology to 12 form transfer to a nonprofit corporation to be known as the State Health 13 Alliance for Records Exchange. 14 15 SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 25-42-103 is amended to read as follows: 16 25-42-103. Office of Health Information Technology - Creation. 17 The Office of Health Information Technology is created within the 18 Department of Health. 19 SECTION 4. Arkansas Code § 25-42-105(b), concerning the duties and 20 21 responsibilities of the Office of Health Information Technology, is amended 22 to read as follows: 23 (b) The Office of Health Information Technology Coordinator shall 24 serve as the executive officer of the office be selected and serve in a 25 manner prescribed by the Director of the Department of Health. 26 27 SECTION 5. Arkansas Code § 25-42-105(c)(5) and (6), concerning the 28 duties and responsibilities of the Office of Health Information Technology, 29 is amended to read as follows: 30 (5) Adopt Recommend to the State Board of Health regarding rules 31 necessary to carry out the policies and objectives of this chapter; 32 (6) Plan, establish, and operate the State Health Alliance for 33 Records Exchange until the time when a nonprofit corporation is formed to 34 operate the State Health Alliance for Records Exchange and the operational 35 responsibility and authority for the State Health Alliance for Records 36 Exchange is transferred to that a nonprofit corporation; and

Arkansas Code § 25-42-106(a)(3)(A), concerning the creation 3 of the State Health Alliance for Records Exchange, is amended to read as 4 follows: 5 (3)(A) Until the a nonprofit corporation is formed operates the 6 State Health Alliance for Records Exchange, the State Health Alliance for 7 Records Exchange shall be established and operated by the Office of Health 8 Information Technology with the advice of the Health Information Exchange 9 Council, consisting of the following members appointed by the Governor Director of the Department of Health: 10 11 (i) The Office of Health Information Technology 12 Coordinator; 13 (ii) A representative of the Department of Finance 14 and Administration; 15 (iii) A representative of the Department of Health; 16 (iv)(iii) A representative of the Department of 17 Human Services; 18 (v)(iv) A representative of the Department of 19 Information Systems; 20 (vi) (v) A representative of the health insurance 21 industry; 22 (vii) The Director of the Department of Health 23 appointed under § 20-7-103; 24 (viii) (vi) A representative of the Arkansas 25 Foundation for Medical Care; 26 (ix)(vii) A representative of the Arkansas Hospital 27 Association; 28 (x)(viii) A representative of the Arkansas Medical 29 Society; 30 (xi)(ix) A representative of the Arkansas Minority 31 Health Commission; 32 (xii)(x) A representative of the Arkansas Nurses 33 Association; 34 (xiii) (xi) A representative of the Division of 35 Science and Technology of the Arkansas Economic Development Commission; 36 (xiv)(xii) A representative of the Arkansas

Arkansas Code § 25-42-106(c), concerning the duties of the 13 State Health Alliance for Records Exchange, is amended to read as follows: 14 (c) All members will serve until the time the nonprofit corporation is 15 formed and operational responsibility and authority for the State Health 16 Alliance for Records Exchange is transferred to that a nonprofit corporation. 17 18 SECTION 8. Arkansas Code § 25-42-106(i), concerning the duties of the State Health Alliance for Records Exchange, is amended to read as follows: 19 20 (i) All identified or deidentified health information contained in, 21 stored in, submitted to, transferred by, or released from the State Health 22 Alliance for Records Exchange is not disclosable under applicable state or 23 federal law <u>except to:</u> 24 (1) A healthcare provider; or (2) Other authorized person or entity as described by policies 25 and rules promulgated by the State Board of Health or the State Alliance for 26 27 Records Exchange. 28 29 SECTION 9. Arkansas Code § 25-42-106(j)(1), concerning the duties of 30 the State Health Alliance for Records Exchange, is amended to read as 31 follows: 32 (j)(1) When the nonprofit corporation is formed Upon the transfer to a 33 nonprofit corporation, the State Health Alliance for Records Exchange shall 34 be governed under the bylaws and incorporation documents of the corporation. 35 36

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
