20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
21

22 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 20-15-1202 is amended to read as follows:  
23 20-15-1202. Statewide immunization registry.

24 (a)(1) The Department of Health shall establish a statewide  
25 immunization registry.

26 (2) Immunization records shall include data as specified by the  
27 department.

28 (b) The department may make information ~~regarding the immunization~~  
29 ~~status of children~~ in the registry available to the parents or guardians of a  
30 child, to providers who report on the immunization status of children in  
31 their care, and to such other persons or organizations designated by rule of  
32 the State Board of Health.

33 (c) The board shall adopt rules to implement this subchapter,  
34 including provisions for confidentiality of medical information.

35 (d) The department may enter into data-sharing agreements with  
36 federal, state, and local jurisdictions as well as the nations that are part



of the Compact of Free Association islands to ensure effective surveillance  
and better immunization planning.
