22	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 6-85-207 is amended to read as follows:			
23	6-85-207. Additional eligibility requirements for traditional students.			
24	In addition to the requirements of § 6-85-206, an applicant is eligible			
25	as a traditional stude	ent if the applicant:		
26	(1) Grad	duated from an Arkansas public high	school and has a	
27	minimum composite scor	re of nineteen (19) on the ACT or t	he equivalent score	
28	on an ACT equivalent;			
29	(2) Has a	a disability identified under the I	ndividuals with	
30	Disabilities Education Act, 20 U.S.C. § 1400 et seq., as it existed on July			
31	l, 2009, and graduated from an Arkansas public high school, and either:			
32	(A) Had a minimum composite score of nineteen (19) on the			
33	ACT or the equivalent score on an ACT equivalent; or			
34	(B) Scored proficient or higher on all state-mandated end-			
35	of-course assessments, including without limitation end-of-course assessments

5	(3) Achieved a minimum composite score of nineteen (19) on the

10	junior or senior in high school, completed the requirements for high school
