I	$\frac{Any}{A}$ person within the jurisdiction of this state who is not licensed		
2	to sell, deliver, or cause to be delivered tobacco products, vapor products,		
3	alternative nicotine products, or e-liquid products to consumers and who		
4	sells, takes orders from, delivers, or causes to be delivered immediately or		
5	in the future any tobacco products, vapor products, alternative nicotine		
6	products, or e-liquid products to consumers,:		
7	(1) For a first offense, may be fined not more than three (3)		
8	times the total of amount of the transaction; and		
9	(2) For a second or subsequent offense, is guilty of a Class A		
10	misdemeanor.

12	SECTION 3. Arkansas Code \S 26-57-256(a)(5)(B)(ii), concerning the		
13	power of the Arkansas Tobacco Control Board to assess civil penalties, is		
14	amended to read as follows:		
15	(ii) In addition, the board may levy a civil penalty		
16	in an amount not to exceed five thousand dollars (\$5,000) for each violation		
17	three (3) times the total of amount of the transaction against $\frac{any}{a}$ person		
18	or entity found to be in violation.
