5	SECTION 2. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the		
6	General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that many citizens of this state		
7	rely upon the use of enhanced security driver's licenses, commercial driver's		
8	licenses, and identification cards; that these enhanced security licenses and		
9	identification cards are needed for airline travel and for business purposes;		
10	that unless this act is effective immediately the issuance of an enhanced		
11	security driver's license will be prohibited. Therefore, an emergency is		
12	declared to exist, and this act being immediately necessary for the		
13	preservation of the public peace, health, and safety shall become effective		
14	on:		
15	(1) The date of its approval by the Governor;		
16	(2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor,		
17	the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the		
18	bill; or		
19	(3) If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is		
20	overridden, the date the last house overrides the veto.
