5	the effective date of this act and shall be called by the Director of the
6	Administrative Office of the Courts.

8	of the membership at the first meeting.
9	(d)(1) The committee shall conduct its meetings at the State Capitol
10	Building or at any place designated by the chair or the chair's designee.
11	(2) Meetings shall be held at least one (1) time every three (3)
12	months but may occur more often at the call of the chair.
13	(e) If a vacancy occurs on the committee, the vacancy shall be filled
14	by the same process as the original appointment.

33	A circuit court clerk or other person authorized to collect the fines
34	under § 16-13-709(a)(1)(A)(i) who does not already record fine assessment and
35	collection data in an electronic form on the effective date of this act shall
36	by March 1, 2019, have established an operational fine assessment and

1	collection system in electronic form for all circuit court cases filed after
2	March 1, 2019, in which the circuit court assesses a fine as a condition of a
3	person's sentence.
