26	SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 27-51-1503 is amended to read as follow	is:
27	7-51-1503. Definitions.	
28	As used in this subchapter:	
29	(1) (Λ) "Handheld wireless telephone" means a wireless	_
30	interactive communication device with which a user can engage in a text-b	ased
31	communication using at least one (1) hand or by reading a text-based	
32	communication.

1	(2)(A) "Hands-free wireless telephone or device" means a
2	wireless telephone or other wireless communication device that allows a user
3	to engage in text-based communication without the use of either hand with an:
4	(i) Internal feature or function; or
5	(ii) Attachment or additional device.
6	(B) A hands-free wireless telephone or device may be a
7	permanent or temporary part of the wireless telephone or other wireless
8	communication device.
9	(C) A hands-free wireless telephone or device may require
10	the use of either hand to activate, deactivate, or initiate a function of the
11	wireless telephone or other communication device; and
12	(3) "Wireless interactive communication" means typing, text
13	messaging, emailing, or accessing information on the Internet with a handheld
14	Wireless telephone.
15	"Access, read, or post to a social networking site" means using a
16	wireless telecommunications device to interact with a web-based service that
17	allows a person to:
18	(A) Construct a profile within a bounded system;
19	(B) Articulate a list of other members with whom the
20	person shares a connection; and
21	(C) Communicate with other members of the site;
22	(2)(A) "Wireless telecommunications device" means a cellular
23	telephone, a text-messaging device, a personal digital assistant, a stand-
24	alone computer, or a substantially similar wireless device that is readily
25	removable from the vehicle and is used to write, send, or read text or data
26	through manual input.
27	(B) "Wireless telecommunications device" does not include
28	<u>a:</u>
29	(i) Citizens band radio;
30	(ii) Citizens band radio hybrid;
31	(iii) Commercial two-way radio communication device;
32	(iv) Two-way radio transmitter or receiver used by a
33	licensee of the Federal Communication Commission in the Amateur Radio
34	Service; or
35	(v) Hands-free wireless telephone or device; and
36	(3) "Write, send, or read a text-based communication" means

1	using a wireless telecommunications device to manually communicate with a
2	person by using a text-based communication commonly referred to as a text
3	message, instant message, or electronic mail.

5	SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 27-51-1504 is amended to read as follows:
6	27-51-1504. Use of a handheld wireless telephone telecommunications
7	device when driving.
8	(a) $\underline{(1)}$ Except as otherwise provided in subsection (b) of this section,
9	a driver of a motor vehicle shall not operate a motor vehicle while use using
10	a handheld wireless telephone for wireless interactive communication $\underline{\text{wireless}}$
11	telecommunications device to:
12	(A) Write, send, or read a text-based communication; or
13	(B) Access, read, or post to a social networking site
14	while operating a motor vehicle.
15	(2) A driver of a motor vehicle is not in violation of
16	subdivision (a)(1) of this section if he or she reads, selects, or enters a
17	telephone number or name in a wireless telecommunications device for the
18	purpose of making a telephone call.
19	(b) (1) A driver of a motor vehicle may use a handheld wireless
20	telephone for wireless interactive communication in emergencies.
21	(2) A person is exempt from the requirements of this section if
22	he or she is:
23	(1) performing his or her Performing official duties as a
24	certified law enforcement officer, firefighter, ambulance driver, or
25	emergency medical technician <u>;</u>
26	(2) Operating a motor vehicle while using a wireless
27	telecommunications device to:
28	(A) Report illegal activity;
29	(B) Summon medical or other emergency assistance;
30	(C) Prevent injury to a person or property;
31	(D) Relay information between a transit or for-hire
32	operator dispatcher, if the wireless telecommunication device is permanently
33	affixed to the motor vehicle; or
34	(E) Navigate using a global positioning system; or
35	(3) A physician or healthcare provider using a wireless
36	telecommunications device to communicate with a hospital, health clinic, or

1	the office of the physician, or to provide for the health care or medical
2	emergency of a person is exempt from the requirements of this section.
3	
4	SECTION 4. Arkansas Code § 27-51-1506 is amended to read as follows:
5	27-51-1506. Penalties.
6	A person who pleads guilty or nolo contendere to or has been found
7	guilty of violating this section commits a violation.
8	(a)(1) A violation of this subchapter is punishable by a fine of not
9	more than two hundred fifty dollars (\$250) for the first offense.
10	(2) Each subsequent violation of this subchapter is punishable
11	by a fine of not more than five hundred dollars (\$500).
12	(b)(l) If a person pleads guilty or nolo contendre to or the finder of
13	fact determines that the person was involved in a collision or accident while
14	in violation of this subchapter, a court shall in addition to any other
15	sentence, assess an additional fine of double the amount of the standard fine
16	imposed under subdivisions (a)(1) and (2) of this section.
17	(2) The law enforcement officer investigating the collision or
18	accident shall indicate on the written accident form that the driver of the
19	motor vehicle was using a wireless telecommunications device at the time of
20	the collision or accident.
21	
22	SECTION 5. Arkansas Code § 27-51-1607 is amended to read as follows:
23	27-51-1607. Penalties.
24	(a)(1) For a first offense under this subchapter, a person shall be
25	issued a citation that is a warning citation, and no court appearance is
26	required and no penalty shall be imposed by the court.
27	(2) A record of each warning citation issued shall be
28	maintained.
29	(b) A person who pleads guilty or nolo contendere to or has been found
30	guilty of violating this subchapter for a second or subsequent offense is
31	guilty of a violation under § 5-1-108 and shall be fined fifty dollars
32	(\$50.00).
33	A violation of this subchapter is punishable by a fine of not more than
34	two hundred fifty dollars (\$250) for the first offense.
35	(2) Each subsequent violation of this subchapter is punishable

by a fine of not more than five hundred dollars (\$500).

(b) If a person pleads guilty or nolo contendre to or the finder of fact determines that the person was involved in a collision or accident while in violation of this subchapter, a court shall in addition to any other sentence, assess an additional fine of double the amount of the standard fine imposed under subdivisions (a)(1) and (2) of this section.
