7	SECTION 2. REAPPROPRIATION - CASH FUNDS. There is hereby appropriated,		
8	to the War Memorial Stadium Commission, to be payable from the cash funds as		
9	defined by Arkansas Code 19-4-801, for the War Memorial Stadium Commission		
10	the following:		
11	(A) Effective July 1, 2017, the balance of the appropriation provided		
12	in Item (A) Section 2 of Act 9 of 2016, for maintenance and replacement of		
13	Field Turf of War Memorial Stadium, in a sum not to exceed\$435,000.		
14	(B) Effective July 1, 2017, the balance of the appropriation provided		
15	in Item (B) Section 2 of Act 9 of 2016, for maintenance, renovation,		
16	equipping, construction, acquisition, improvement, upgrade and repair of the		
17	Southwest Concourse Restrooms of War Memorial Stadium, in a sum not to exceed		
18	\$42,500.		
19	(C) Effective July 1, 2017, the balance of the appropriation provided		
20	in Item (C) Section 2 of Act 9 of 2016, for replacement, maintenance,		
21	renovation, equipping, construction, acquisition, and improvement of the		
22	North and South Scoreboards of the War Memorial Stadium, in a sum not to		
23	exceed\$33,336.		
24	(D) Effective July 1, 2017, the balance of the appropriation provided		
25	in Item (D) Section 2 of Act 9 of 2016, for various maintenance, renovation,		
26	equipping, construction, acquisition, improvement, upgrade, and repair of		
27	real property and facilities, in a sum not to exceed\$6,771.

29	SECTION 3. DISBURSEMENT CONTROLS. (A) No contract may be awarded nor		
30	obligations otherwise incurred in relation to the project or projects		
31	described herein in excess of the State Treasury funds actually available		
32	therefor as provided by law. Provided, however, that institutions and		
33	agencies listed herein shall have the authority to accept and use grants and		
34	donations including Federal funds, and to use its unobligated cash income or		
35	funds, or both available to it, for the purpose of supplementing the State		
36	Treasury funds for financing the entire costs of the project or projects		

- enumerated herein. Provided further, that the appropriations and funds otherwise provided by the General Assembly for Maintenance and General Operations of the agency or institutions receiving appropriation herein shall not be used for any of the purposes as appropriated in this act.
 - (B) The restrictions of any applicable provisions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law and any other applicable fiscal control laws of this State and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of any funds provided by this act unless specifically provided otherwise by law.

Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2017 is essential to the operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2017 could work irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2017.
