- SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 27-35-210, concerning permits for special 31
- 32 cargoes, is amended to add an additional subsection to read as follows:
- 33 (p)(1) Except as provided in subdivision (a)(2)(A) of this section,
- the State Highway Commission may issue a special permit for the unlimited statewide movement of a vehicle used by a farm machinery equipment dealer for 35
- 36 the transport of farm machinery equipment if the dealer:

I	(A) Applies to the commission for an annual permit; and
2	(B) Pays a fee of two hundred fifty (\$250) dollars per
3	vehicle authorized under subsection (p) of this section.
4	(2) A special permit under subdivision (p)(1) of this section is
5	required for a vehicle that has a total outside width, unladen or with load,
6	in excess of one hundred forty-four inches (144").
