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3	SECTION 2. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the		
4	General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that it is vital to the state that		
5	the investments of the state are coordinated by the chief investment officers		
6	that the state greatly relies upon the expertise of the chief investment		
7	officer; and that this act is immediately necessary to ensure that the chief		
8	investment officer has the resources necessary to safeguard the investments		
9	of the state. Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist, and this act		
10	being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health		
11	and safety shall become effective on:		
12	(1) The date of its approval by the Governor;		
13	(2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor,		
14	the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the		
15	<pre>bill; or</pre>		
16	(3) If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is		
17	overridden, the date the last house overrides the veto.		
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
