8	(a) The Department of Human Services shall:	
9	(1)(A) Establish rules for the oversight, accountability,	
10	administration, award, and distribution of funds received by the department	
11	under the Older Americans Act of 1965, 42 U.S.C. § 3001 et seq., and from the	
12	state for programs administered under the act.	
13	(B) The rules established by the department shall include	
14	requirements that an entity must meet in order to receive and continue	
15	receiving funds under this section; and	
16	(2) Provide the House Committee on Aging, Children and Youth,	
17	Legislative and Military Affairs with an annual report accounting for funds	
18	received by the department under the Older Americans Act of 1965, 42 U.S.C. §	
19	3001 et seq., and from the state for programs administered under the act and	
20	disbursed by the department.	
21	(b)(1)(A) The department shall annually award funds under this section	
22	to one (1) or more entities that the department determines are eligible to	
23	receive funds under the Older Americans Act of 1965, 42 U.S.C. § 3001 et seq.	
24	(B) The department may set the:	
25	(i) Funding allocated to each region of the state	
26	based on statistical need;	
27	(ii) Method by which each region of the state shall	
28	receive funds under this section; and	
29	(iii) Method by which an entity shall receive funds	
30	awarded under this section.	
31	(2) An allocation, award, or distribution of funds made by the	
32	department under this section may be reviewed by the House Committee on

36	(c)(1)(A) An entity that receives funds under this section from the

4	this section shall include without limitation an accounting for services	
5	rendered, the number of individuals served, and the moneys expended.	
6	(2) An entity that receives funds under this section shall be	
7	bonded and is liable to the state for any misuse of funds received by the	
8	entity.	
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
