1 supervision shall comply with legal requirements and meet industry standards. 2 (3)(A)(i) The master plumber or journeyman plumber shall observe 3 the work of an apprentice plumber in person at regular and reasonable 4 intervals. 5 (ii) One (1) master plumber or journeyman plumber 6 may supervise up to three (3) apprentice plumbers on a single job. (B) The Career Education and Workforce Development Board 7 8 shall promulgate rules which that determine the regular and reasonable 9 intervals under subdivision (b)(3)(A) of this section in consideration of 10 the: 11 (i) Nature of the work; and 12 (ii) Skill and experience of the apprentice plumber. 13 (4)(A) The supervising master plumber or journeyman plumber 14 shall remain within reasonable proximity of the apprentice plumber while work 15 is being performed. 16 (B) The proximity of the supervising plumber to the 17 apprentice plumber is reasonable if: 18 (i) The job site is a single-family residence or a 19 project that does not require a contractor's license, and the supervising 20 plumber is: 21 (a) Within the line of sight of the apprentice 22 plumber; 23 (b) At the same street address at which the 24 apprentice plumber is working; 25 (c) At the street address adjacent to or 26 adjoining the street address at which the apprentice plumber is working; or 27 (d) Within the same geographical subdivision 28 in which the apprentice is located; or 29 (ii) The job site is not a single-family residence, 30 requires a contractor's license, and: 31 (a) The supervising plumber is within the line 32 of sight of the apprentice plumber; or 33 (b) The supervising plumber is within two hundred fifty (250) yards of the apprentice plumber, and the supervising 34 35 plumber and the apprentice plumber are within the property boundaries of the 36 job site.

1	(3)(A) An apprentice plumber who is in his or her linal year of		
2	an apprenticeship may engage in plumbing without the direct supervision of $\underline{a}$		
3	master plumber or journeyman plumber if he or she is working under the		
4	indirect supervision of a master plumber or journeyman plumber.		
5	(B)(i) As used in this section, "indirect supervision"		
6	means that an apprentice plumber under subdivision (b)(5)(A) of this section		
7	is able to contact a master plumber or journeyman plumber for direction or		
8	advice, but the master plumber or journeyman plumber does not have to meet		
9	the reasonable proximity requirements under subdivision (b)(4)(B)(i) and (ii)		
10	of this section.		
11	(ii) An apprentice plumber may contact a master		
12	plumber or journeyman plumber under subdivision (b)(5)(B) in person or by		
13	telephone call, text message, electronic mail, or other similar form of		
14	communication.		
15	(C) An apprentice plumber under subdivision (b)(5)(A) of		
16	this section shall possess and be capable of providing to an inspector a		
17	valid and unexpired identification card issued by the local apprenticeship		
18	committee that indicates the apprentice is in his or her final year of		
19	apprenticeship.
