20	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 27-51-1602(2)-(3), concerning the			
21	definition of a handheld wireless telephone and a hands-free wireless

11	SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 27-51-1602(6)-(7), concerning the		
12	definitions of a wireless interactive communication and a wireless telephone		
13	are repealed:		
14	(6) "Wireless interactive communication" means talking, typing,		
15	emailing, or accessing information on the Internet with a wireless telephone		
16	and and		
17	(7)(A) "Wireless telephone" means a wireless interactive		
18	communication device.		
19	(B) "Wireless telephone" includes a handheld wireless		
20	telephone and a hands-free wireless telephone or device.

22	SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 27-51-1603 is amended to read as follows:		
23	27-51-1603. Restrictions on drivers under 18 years of age.		
24	(a) Except as provided under subsection (b) of this section, a driver		
25	of a motor vehicle who is under eighteen (18) years of age shall not use a		
26	<u>handheld</u> wireless telephone <u>or device or a hands-free wireless telephone or</u>		
27	device, for wireless interactive communication while operating a motor		
28	vehicle.		
29	(b) A driver of a motor vehicle who is under eighteen (18) years of		
30	age may use a <u>handheld</u> wireless telephone <u>or device or a hands-free wireless</u>		
31	telephone or device for wireless interactive communication while operating a		
32	motor vehicle for an emergency purpose only.

34	SECTION 4. Arkansas Code § 27-51-1604 is amended to read as follows:		
35	27-51-1604. Restrictions on <u>use of a handheld wireless telephone or</u>		
36	device generally drivers at least 18 but under 21 years of age.		

I	(a)(1) Except as otherwise provided in this section, the driver of a
2	motor vehicle who is at least eighteen (18) but under twenty one (21) years
3	of age shall not use a handheld wireless telephone for wireless interactive
4	communication while operating a motor vehicle.
5	(2) The driver of a motor vehicle who is at least eighteen (18)
6	but under twenty-one (21) years of age may use a hands-free wireless
7	telephone or device for wireless interactive communication while operating a
8	motor vehicle.
9	(b) A driver of a motor vehicle who is at least eighteen (18) but
10	under twenty one (21) years of age may use a handheld wireless telephone for
11	wireless interactive communication while operating a motor vehicle for an
12	emergency purpose only.
13	(a) A driver shall not operate a motor vehicle on the traveled portion
14	of a public street or roadway while using a handheld wireless telephone or
15	device.
16	(b) It is not a violation to use a handheld wireless telephone or
17	device:
18	(1) For an emergency purpose; and
19	(2) While temporarily pulled over to the shoulder or safe area
20	that is not within the flow of traffic or a traveled portion of a public
21	street or roadway, if the motor vehicle has come to a complete stop.
22	(c) For the purpose of this section, "roadway" means that portion of a
23	highway improved, designed, or ordinarily used for vehicular travel.
24	(d) A person performing his or her official duties as a certified law
25	enforcement officer, firefighter, emergency medical personnel or other public
26	safety personnel is exempt from the requirements of this section.
