1	(2) The amount of any civil penalty levied by the board may be		
2	recovered in a civil action brought by the board in a court of competent		
3	jurisdiction without paying costs or giving bond for costs.		
4	(b) In addition to the civil penalty provided in this section, the		
5	board is authorized to petition any court of competent jurisdiction without		
6	paying costs or giving bond for costs to:		
7	(1) Enjoin or restrain any violation of or compel compliance		
8	with the provisions of this chapter and any rules, regulations, or orders		
9	issued thereunder;		
10	(2) Affirmatively order that remedial measures be taken as may		
11	be necessary or appropriate to implement or effectuate the purposes and		
12	intent of this chapter; and		
13	(3) Recover all costs, expenses, and damages to the board and		
14	any other agency or subdivision of the state in enforcing or effectuating the		
15	provisions of this subchapter.		
16	(b) If a person who is assessed a penalty for a third time under		
17	subsection (a) of this section fails to pay the penalty amounts to the board		
18	within six (6) months from the date the third penalty is assessed, the $person$		
19	shall be deemed guilty of a Class B misdemeanor and upon conviction shall be		
20	punished by a fine not exceeding one thousand dollars (\$1,000) or by		
21	imprisonment in the county jail for not more than ninety (90) days, or by		
22	both fine and imprisonment.		
23	(c)(1) If an unlicensed person who is required to be licensed performs		
24	HVACR work in violation of this subchapter, that person shall not be entitled		
25	to a mechanic's and materialman's lien, a laborer's lien, a repairmen's lien,		
26	or any other artisan's lien for work done in violation of this subchapter.		
27	(2) An unlicensed person in subdivision (c)(l) of this section		
28	shall not be entitled to receive any payment for work he or she undertook		
29	while unlicensed and any payment received by the unlicensed person shall be		
30	remitted to the board.		
31	(d) All fines collected under this section shall be deposited into the		
32	State Treasury and credited to the HVACR Licensing Fund to be used to defray		
33	the costs of administering this chapter.

35 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 17-33-202 is amended to read as follows: 36 17-33-202. Powers and duties.

1	The HVACR Licensing Board may:	
2	(1) Adopt certain rules and regulations to ensure the proper	
3	administration and enforcement of this chapter;	
4	(2) Adopt a mechanical code and standards for the conduct of	
5	HVACR work;	
6	(3) Assist and advise the Department of Health on all matters	
7	related to the licensing of HVACR maintenance work;	
8	(4) Conduct hearings on all matters related to the licensing and	
9	inspection of HVACR work;	
10	(5) Establish HVACR code inspection programs;	
11	(6) Conduct investigations into the qualifications of applicants	
12	for licensure at the request of the department;	
13	(7) Review applications for examination for a Class A, Class B,	
14	Class C, Class D, Class E, and Class L license;	
15	(8) Establish by board regulation rule a minimum level of	
16	general liability insurance coverage for a license if the board determines	
17	that a specific class of license requires insurance coverage;	
18	(9) Assist and advise the department in other such matters as	
19	requested by the department; and	
20	(10) Establish fees for the proper administration of the	
21	requirements of this chapter <u>and</u>	
22	(11) Assess and collect penalties from a person who violates any	
23	provision of this chapter or violates any rule, or order of the board or any	
24	permit, license, or certification.
