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- SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 6-16-102(c), concerning the average amounts of planned instructional time, is amended to read as follows:

 14 school day does not average averages not less than six (6) hours the amounts
 15 of instructional time under subdivision (a)(1) of this section each day or
 16 thirty (30) hours each week.

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- SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 6-16-132(b)(1), concerning physical activity requirements, is amended to add an additional subdivision to read as follows:
- 21 (b)(1)(A) The physical education curriculum and physical activity 22 requirements for every public school student who is able to participate are:
- 23 (i) Except as provided in subdivision (b)(l)(A)(ii)
- 24 of this section, for students in kindergarten through grade six (K-6):
